Other species not mentioned will be charged at the mixed pulp or saw price.

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The performance bond will be 15% of the total sale value. The contract end date is **June 30, 2025**.

**SPECIAL SALE CONDITIONS:**

Equipment use is restricted to dry or frozen ground conditions due to wet soil conditions.

Use of a continuous rotating saw head is allowed only in the coppice and shelterwood areas.

No cutting during the months of April, May, or June in selection areas due to bark being easily damaged at these times.

Avoid damaging green marked trees in the shelterwood area.

All slash and ends will be removed from Price Creek Road and its ditches concurrently and with each truckload. All slash within 100 feet of Price Creek Road will be lopped and scattered to within 2 feet of the ground by the contractor.

Price Creek Road may be used as a landing or decking area with prior notification.

Upon sale completion, all landings and access points along Price Creek Road shall be re-ditched and returned to the condition prior to the sale. Any damage to Price Creek Road is the responsibility of the contractor.

No equipment use, felling, or slash is permitted in wetlands.

Cutting will not be allowed in the shelterwood area until scarification is completed by the State in. Harvest shall be completed within one year of scarification. Do not cut or disturb aspen.

New road construction is optional and is limited to proposed layout shown on map. New road will avoid wetlands and ephemeral ponds. Modifications can be made with approval of the forester.
