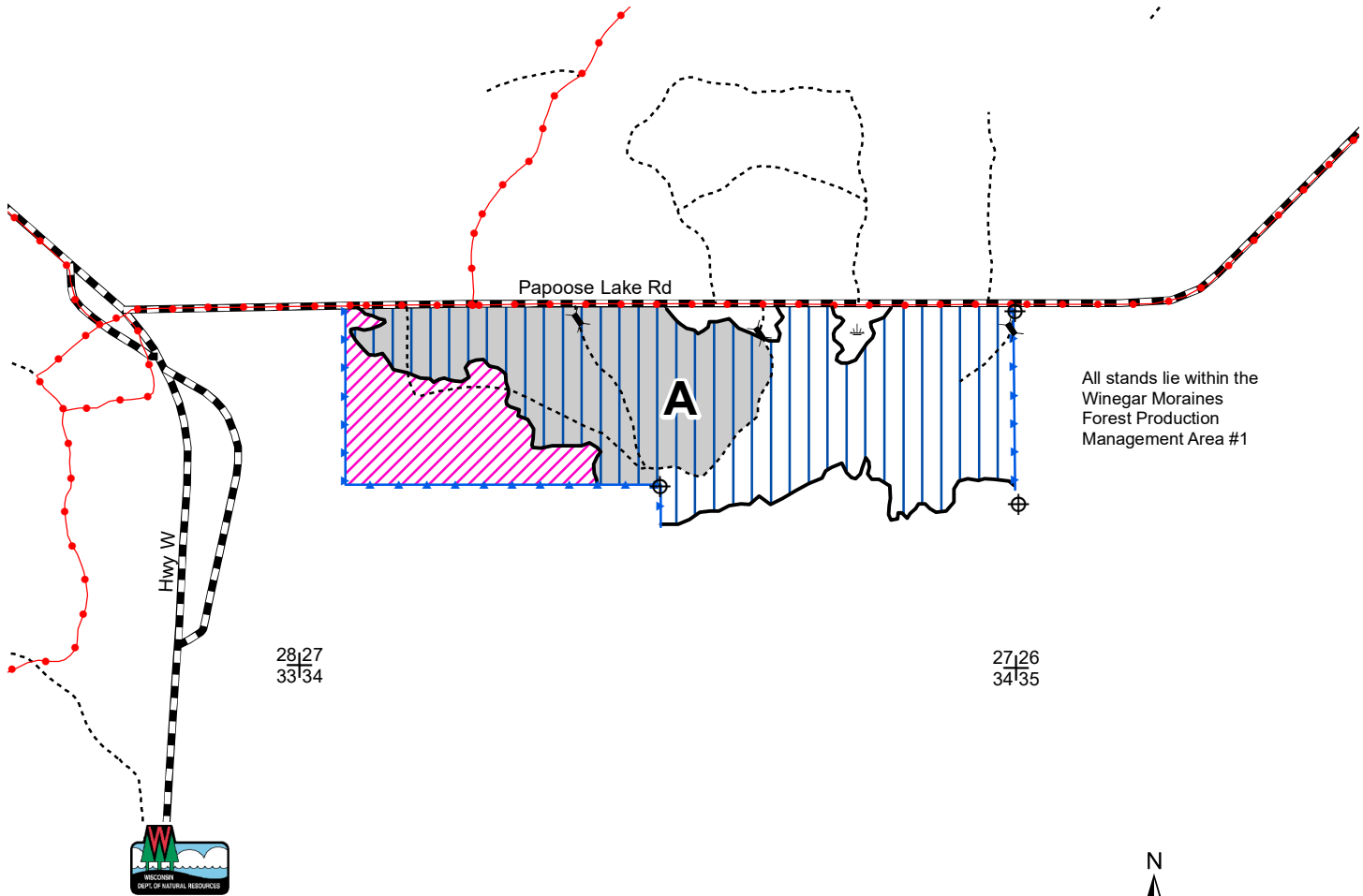

-  Northern Hardwood Area (118 Acres): Cut all orange marked trees. Cut all merchantable ash and spruce. Cut all aspen west of North-South woods road in area labeled Zone A.
-  Aspen Area (30 Acres): Cut all aspen, hardwoods and spruce greater than 1" in DBH. Do not cut white cedar, white pine or red oak.

***Cut all balsam fir. Refer to the Special Conditions on the Prospectus for options on how the balsam fir is utilized.***

***Do NOT cut trees marked with green paint.***

The cutting area is approximately 148 acres.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter chosen by the bidder will be cut and utilized. Whole tree utilization is NOT allowed.

<sup>2</sup>Approximately 47% basswood, 33% sugar maple, 12% ash, 8% red maple and <1% white birch. Volume includes approximately 224 MBF basswood, 42 MBF ash and 31 MBF sugar maple.

Sale contains approximately 28 tons/acre or 12 cords/acre.

Special Conditions

1. Rutting will be monitored and if soil disturbances become excessive (based on established thresholds defined in the contract), harvesting operations may be suspended until the affected areas are repaired properly. Harvesting may not resume until field conditions improve sufficiently to avoid rutting.
2. **There is an estimated 290 tons of Balsam Fir on the sale.** There are two options regarding how the balsam fir may be utilized:
  - A - the merchantable wood can be utilized and hauled from the sale under a Forest Products Permit at the rate of \$4.00 per ton or
  - B – the balsam fir shall be cut into pieces no longer than 5 feet in length and left to lie as coarse woody debris.
3. All landings and any new roads must be approved prior to sale start up. All roads must be cleared of debris and leveled upon sale completion.
4. Treat all slash within 50 feet of Papoose Lake Road to lie within 2 feet of the ground.
5. Cutting must be concurrent for all species.
6. Do not cut, knock down or utilize any dead trees unless they pose an operational safety risk.
7. If the contract is to be worked on during multiple time periods a mid-contract “pull-off” inspection meeting will be required. One week notice shall be given by the contractor prior to moving equipment off-site. During the “pull-off” inspection, provisions needing attention will be documented. The contractor at that time can decide to remedy them before pulling equipment off or rectify them when moving back onto the site. If the latter is chosen, documented items shall be addressed before harvesting can continue.

**Notice:** Completion of this form is mandatory. The Department will not recognize your bid unless you complete and submit this form. Personal information collected will be used for program administration and may be provided to requesters as required by Wisconsin's Public Records law [ss. 19.31-19.39, Wis. Stats.].

I also understand that if I am awarded the contract and fail to execute it or work under it, I will be required to forfeit to the Department an amount equal to 10% of my total bid amount.** Failure to forfeit the 10% penalty will result in being considered ineligible to bid on any state timber sales for a two-year duration. In the event the highest bidder can not or will not sign the contract, the award may be made to the next highest qualified bid.
