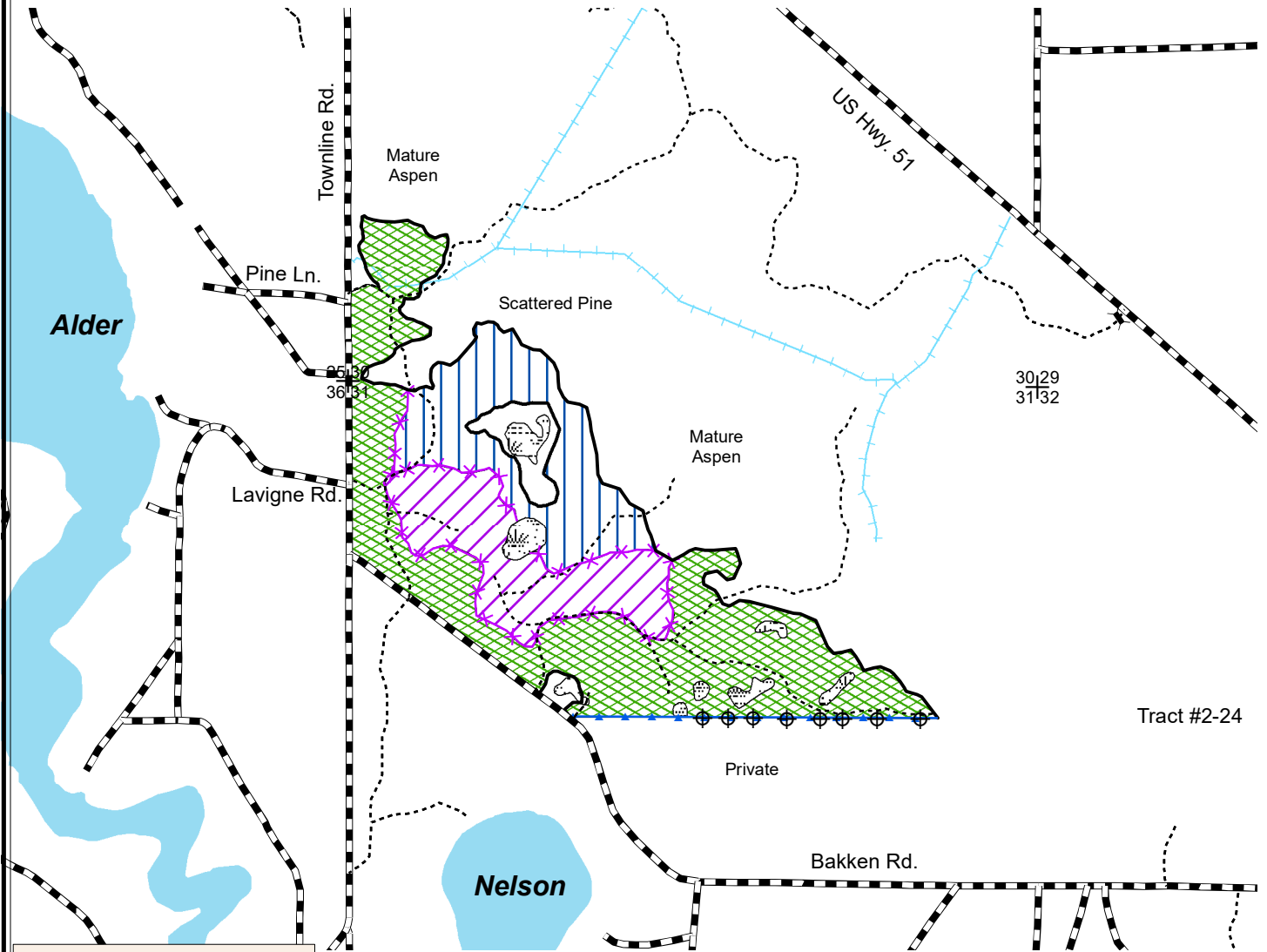


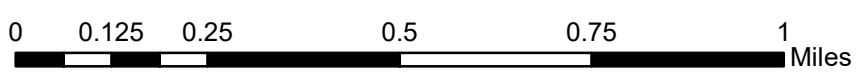

- Aspen Coppice (37 Acres): Cut all aspen, oak, red maple, white birch and cherry larger than 1" DBH as well as orange marked pine.
- Pine Thinning (85 Acres): Cut all orange marked trees. Trees marked with an orange "X" shall be felled and left in place.
- Pine Conversion (32 Acres): Cut all trees larger than 1" DBH **EXCEPT** pine greater than 28" DBH.

Another Snort

Vilas County

The cutting area is approximately 154 acres.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum 4" top diameter will be cut and utilized.

Whole tree utilization is allowed.

1 Approximately 85% red maple, 10% white birch and 5% cherry.

Sale contains approximately 39 tons/acre or approximately 18 cords/acre.

Red Pine averages 18" DBH. White Pine averages 18" DBH. Aspen averages 7" DBH.

Special Conditions:

1. All slash within the **Pine Conversion** area must be piled or windrowed for future site preparation. Slash throughout the remainder of the sale must be evenly scattered and pulled back from town road right of ways. Trees felled across blue paint lines and red paint lines must be pulled back into the sale area prior to processing.
2. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested.
3. All landings and any new roads must be approved prior to sale start up. No decking will be allowed along Bakken Rd or Townline Rd. without Town approval. All woods roads must be cleared of debris and leveled upon completion of sale.
4. Do not harvest trees or operate equipment with 15 feet of any ephemeral pond. No slash or logging debris shall be deposited within ephemeral ponds.
5. All pine products cut between April 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from the time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to April 1 of each year.
6. Felling and skidding damage to residual trees must be avoided. Do not knock down or utilize any dead trees unless they pose a safety hazard.
7. If the contract is to be worked on during multiple time periods a mid-contract "pull-off" inspection meeting will be required. One-week notice shall be given by the contractor prior to moving equipment off-site. During the "pull-off" inspection provisions needing attention will be documented. The contractor at this time can decide to remedy them before pulling off or rectify them when moving back onto the site. If the latter is chosen documented items shall be addressed before harvesting can continue.

Notice: Completion of this form is mandatory. The Department will not recognize your bid unless you complete and submit this form. Personal information collected will be used for program administration and may be provided to requesters as required by Wisconsin's Public Records law [ss. 19.31-19.39, Wis. Stats.].

In the event the highest bidder can not or will not sign the contract, the award may be made to the next highest qualified bid.
