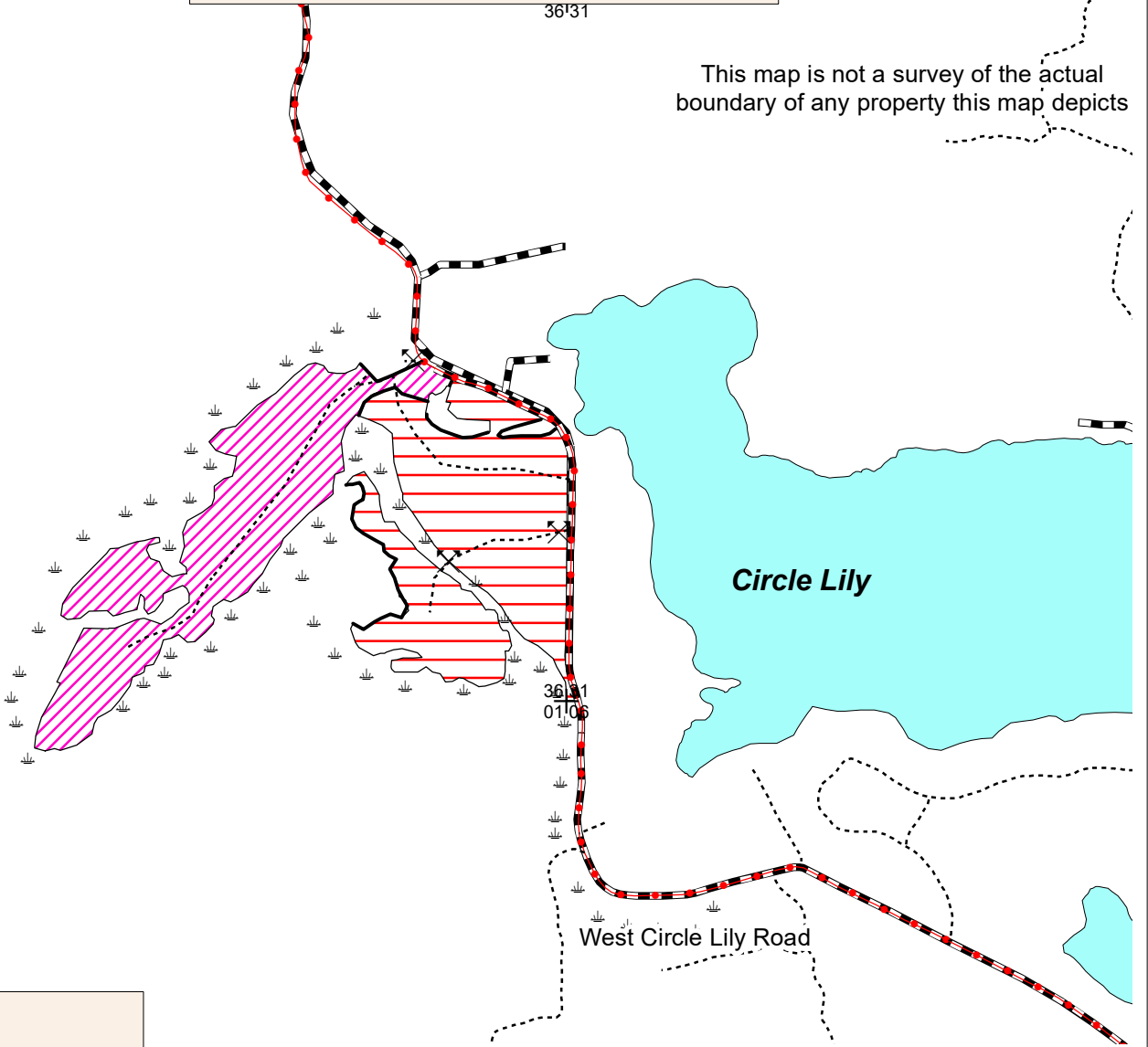

Coppice Area - (53 acres): Cut all aspen and red maple over 2", cut all merchantable white birch, balsam fir. Cut white pine 12" or greater.



Thinning area- (60 acres): Cut all orange marked trees, aspen, white birch, red maple and balsam fir. In certain areas access corridors will need to be cut in. Cut access rows 13' wide.

The cutting area is approximately 113 acres.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum 4" top diameter will be cut and utilized.

PW¹ --Includes approximately 70MBF White Pine of potential logs.

PR² – Includes approximately 25MBF Red Pine of potential logs.

MX³ –Includes approximately 40MBF White Birch of potential logs. MX contain approximately 53% white birch and 47% red maple.

Note sale volume equates to 37 tons/acre or approximately 16 cords per acre. Volumes above reflect utilization to 4" top.

Special Conditions:

1. Harvest will be permitted during dry or frozen conditions only.
2. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested.
3. Do not cut, knock down, or utilize any dead trees unless they pose an operational safety risk.
4. All pine products cut between April 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to April 1 of each year.
5. Biomass harvest and whole tree skidding will not be allowed.
6. All landings and any new roads must be approved prior to sale start up. All roads must be cleared of debris and leveled upon sale completion.
7. Decking of wood will not be permitted along West Circle Lily Road without town permission.
8. Slash must be lopped and scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and pulled back at least 20 feet from the roadside. No trees shall be felled across any redline, blueline or into any wetland areas. Trees must be pulled back inside the sale boundary.
9. Follow WI BMP's for water quality at all times. No equipment is allowed within 15 feet of ephemeral ponds or wetlands.
10. If the contract is to be worked on during multiple time periods a mid-contract "pull-off" inspection meeting will be required. One-week notice shall be given by the contractor prior to moving equipment off-site. During the "pull-off" inspection provisions needing attention will be documented. The contractor at this time can decide to remedy them before pulling off or rectify them when moving back onto the site. If the latter is chosen documented items shall be addressed before harvesting can continue.
