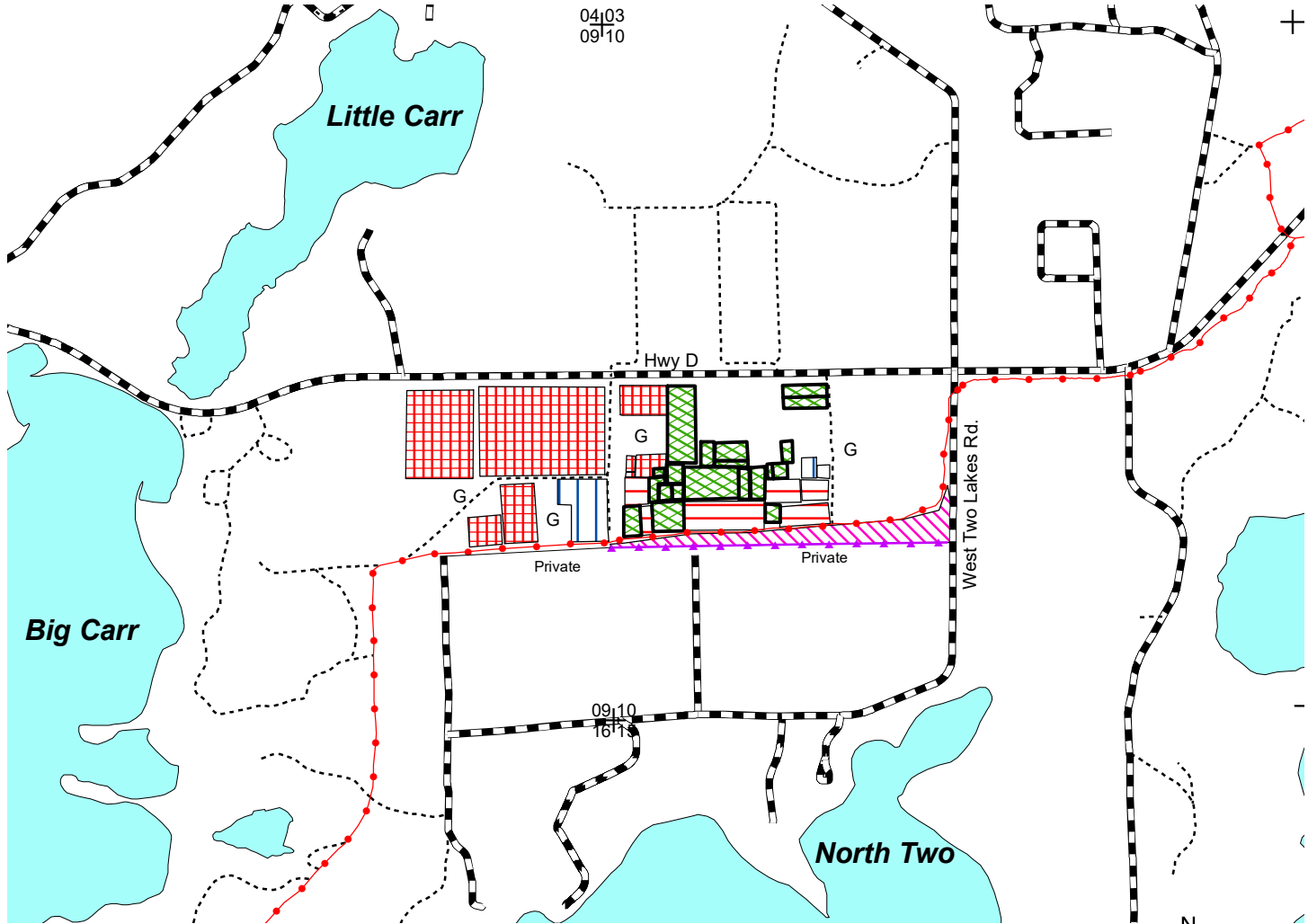

- Select Removal (30 Acres): Cut blue marked trees.
- Clear Cut (14 Acres): Cut all trees including red marked boundary trees and all trees 1-5 inches in diameter.
- Row Thin (7 Acres): Cut blue marked rows. Rows run east and west.
- Row Thin (4 Acres): Cut blue marked rows. Rows run north and south.
- Oak Thinning (8 Acres): Cut all aspen, birch, maple and blue marked trees.

Note: Oak Thinning harvesting operations only allowed July 16 - April 14.

The cutting area is approximately 63 acres.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum 4" top diameter will be cut and utilized.

1 Red Pine Includes a potential 51 MBF of sawlog material.

2 Spruce consists of approximately 60% spruce (980 tons), 18% white pine (295 tons), 16% jack pine (270 tons), 4% tamarack (65 tons) and 2% balsam fir (40 tons). Included is a potential 57 MBF of sawlog material.

3 Mixed Hardwood consists of approximately 44% oak (135 tons), 27% aspen (85 tons) and 29% maple (90 tons). Included is an estimated 5 MBF of sawlog material.

Total sale volume equates to approximately 37.4 tons/acre or 17.5 cords/acre.

Special Conditions:

1. Harvesting operations in oak thinning stand allowed July 16th – April 14th.
2. Contractor must have harvester/operator participate in a pre-sale meeting and walk-through of sale area with DNR Forester prior to any harvesting activity. Several portions of the sale area require trees between the harvest blocks to be removed. One clear-cut block must have several mature balsam clumps retained.
3. Snowmobile trails must be kept free of debris and left in good condition for vehicle traffic at all times.
4. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested.
5. Biomass harvesting is not allowed.
6. No tops or slash allowed across any property line. Slash within 50 feet of the highways/town roads must be lopped and scattered within 2 feet of the ground and pulled back into the sale area at least 10 feet from the edges of those areas.
7. All pine products cut between April 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from the time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to April 1 of each year.
8. If the contract is to be worked on during multiple time periods a mid-contract "pull-off" inspection meeting will be required. One-week notice shall be given by the contractor prior to moving equipment off-site. During the "pull-off" inspection, provisions needing attention will be documented. The contractor at that time can decide to remedy them before pulling equipment off or rectify them when moving back onto the site. If the latter is chosen, documented items shall be addressed before harvesting can continue.

Notice: Completion of this form is mandatory. The Department will not recognize your bid unless you complete and submit this form. Personal information collected will be used for program administration and may be provided to requesters as required by Wisconsin's Public Records law [ss. 19.31-19.39, Wis. Stats.].

In the event the highest bidder can not or will not sign the contract, the award may be made to the next highest qualified bid.
