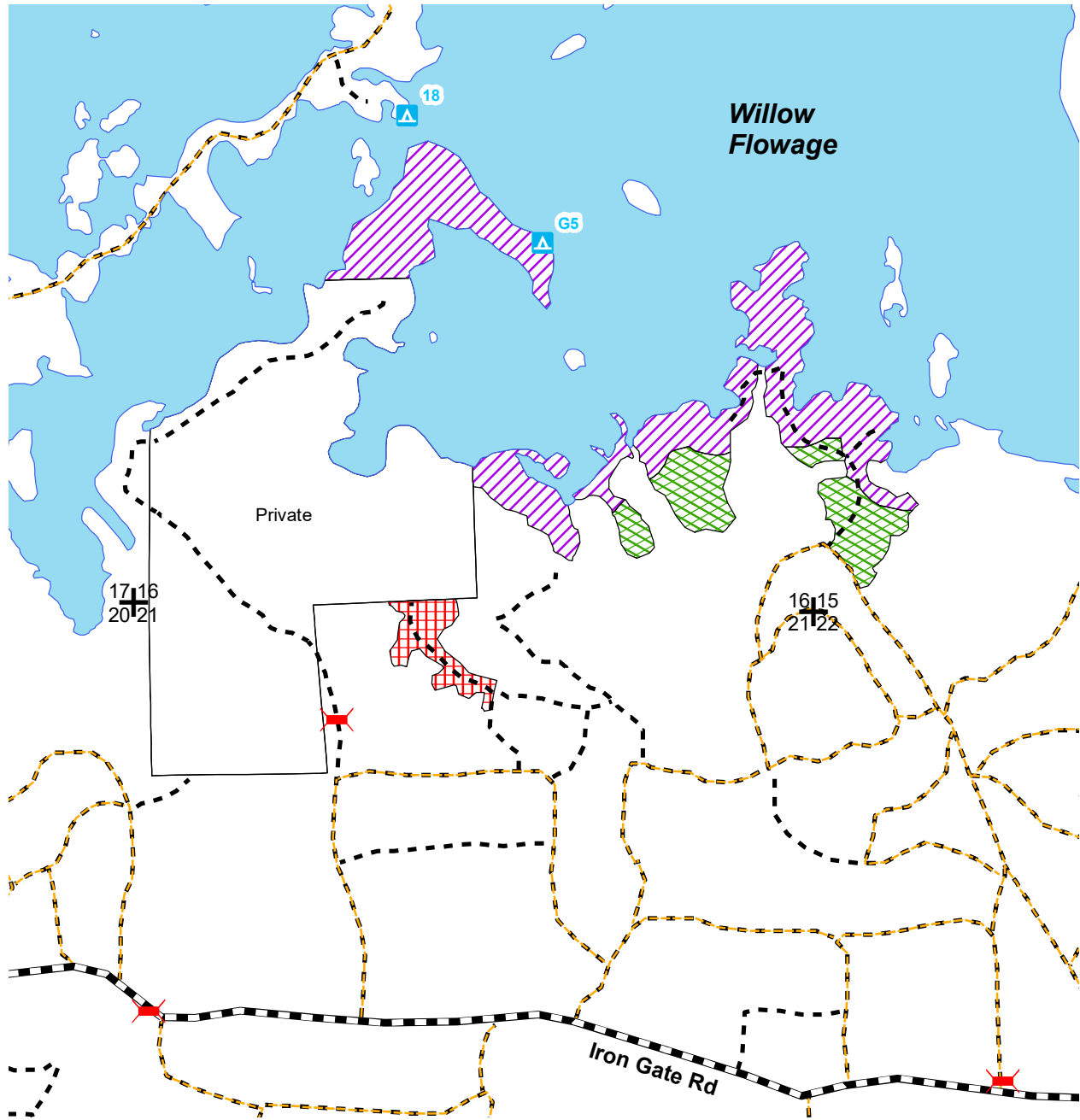


**Willow Flowage Scenic Waters Area**

**Comp 7 Stand 3 (61 acres)** - is 1947 origin red maple mixed with fir, birch, aspen, pine, and spruce. This stand is entirely within the Willow Scenic Mgmt area and will be thinned. Longer-lived species will be favored and pine regeneration will be encouraged throughout. Planting or seeding of pine may also occur after the harvest along with any needed site prep.

**Comp 7 Stand 8 (19 acres)** - is the same maple stand as above except it's within the Forest Production Area. Maple and other short-lived species will be regenerated. Most pine, spruce, and other long-lived species will be retained.

**Comp 10 Stand 3 (7 acres)** - is 1973 origin fir/aspen stand that will be regenerated. Most pine & spruce will remain following the harvest.
