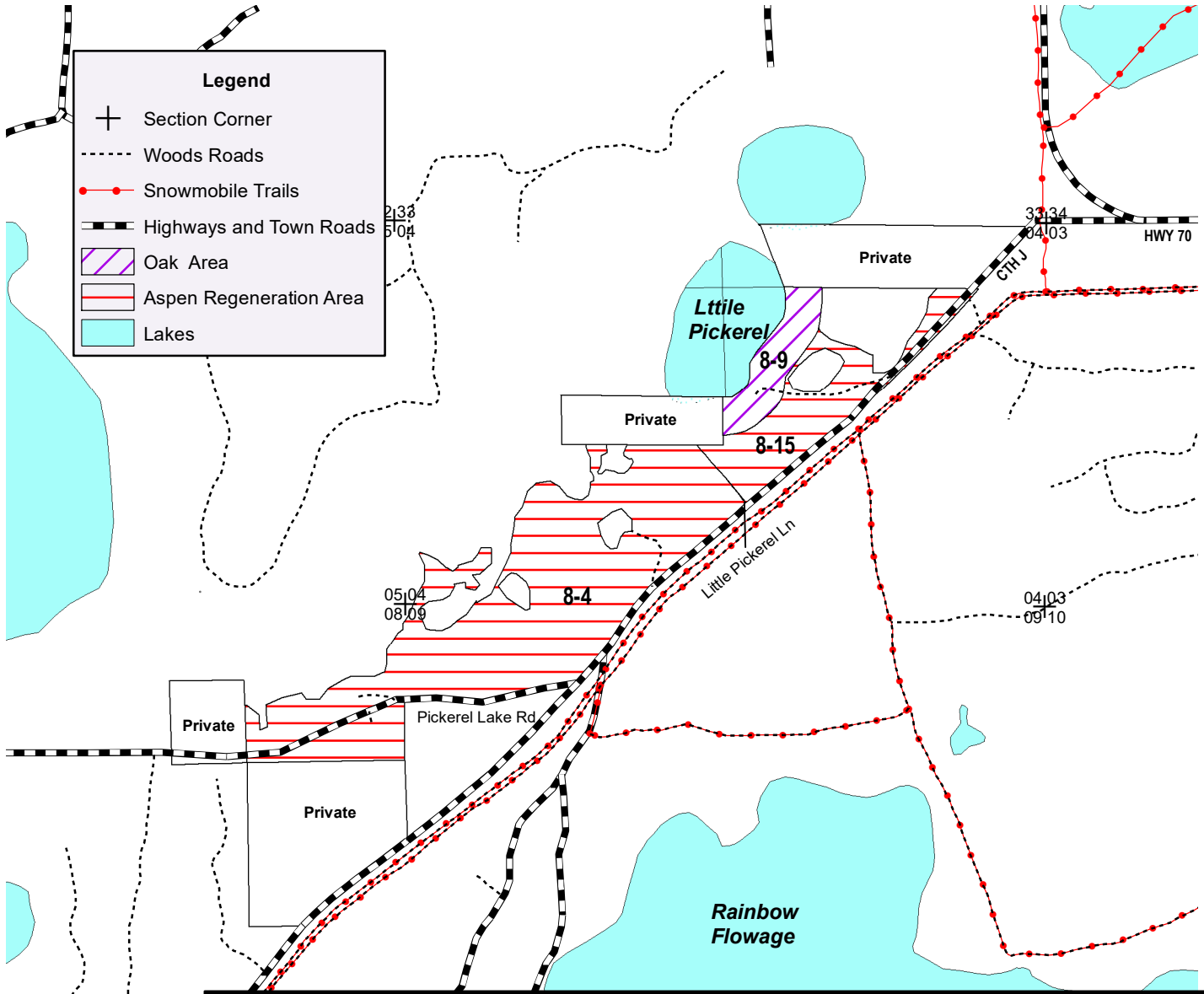


**Northern Highland - American Legion State Forest**

**Area 6 - Oneida Sandy Plains - Forest Production**

Stands 4 & 15 (110 Acres) are comprised of 48 year old & 39 year old well stocked aspen poletimber with associated white birch, red maple, balsam fir and oak poletimber. Some higher stocked clumps of red and white pine sawtimber are also scattered throughout. The goal is to maintain aspen as a strong component across the landscape. The aspen will be regenerated via a coppice with standards forest treatment.

Stand 9 (11 Acres) is a well stocked 84 year old stand of oak pole and sawtimber with other associated shorter lived species. This stand will receive an intermediate thinning to promote the health and vigor of the oak and scattered pine. Longer lived species and aesthetics are also a management goal within the RMZ of Little Pickerel Lake.

Biomass harvesting is restricted due to the nutrient poor soils. There is good access to County Hwy J.
