We currently have a 2-mile trail that is located down the road which requires riders to trailer their bikes to that 2-mile trail. We recently opened the new 8-mile trail that is in the main entrance of the park. The South Branch of the Embarrass River intersects the park causing the two trails to be spilt this bridge will connect all OHM trail systems.

### Trail Project Detailed Description

Tigerton OHV Park & Campground would like to install a bridge to connect the two off-highway motorcycle trail segments on the park property. A two-mile segment was previously completed. To access this trail segment, riders must leave the park and travel on a county highway to get to the portion of the property where the trail is located. This requires a separate registration station at that site. As of May 1st, we opened our new eight-mile trail segment in another portion of the park. This segment can be accessed from inside the main park. A river intersects the property preventing the connection of two trail segments. We need to install a bridge inside the park to connect the two trail segments and eliminate the need to exit the park in travel the county highway to get to segment of the trail. Currently limited use motorcycles must trailer on the highway since they are not DOT licensed. Installing the bridge will eliminate safety concerns involved with leaving the park and riding on the highway to get to the two-mile trail segment. The bridge could also be used by hikers, bicycle list, and equestrians in the park. The bridge would not be open to ATV/UTV/4WD. The Village of Tigerton (Tigerton OHV Park & Campground) also submitted the RTP grant. If the RTP is approved, we would want \$22,500 which would be half of the total cost of the bridge. If the RTP is not approved, we are asking for the full amount of the bridge to be paid for by the OHM program. Tigerton OHV Park is open May-October. DNR questions are pending. This project will not cause any disturbance to wetland.

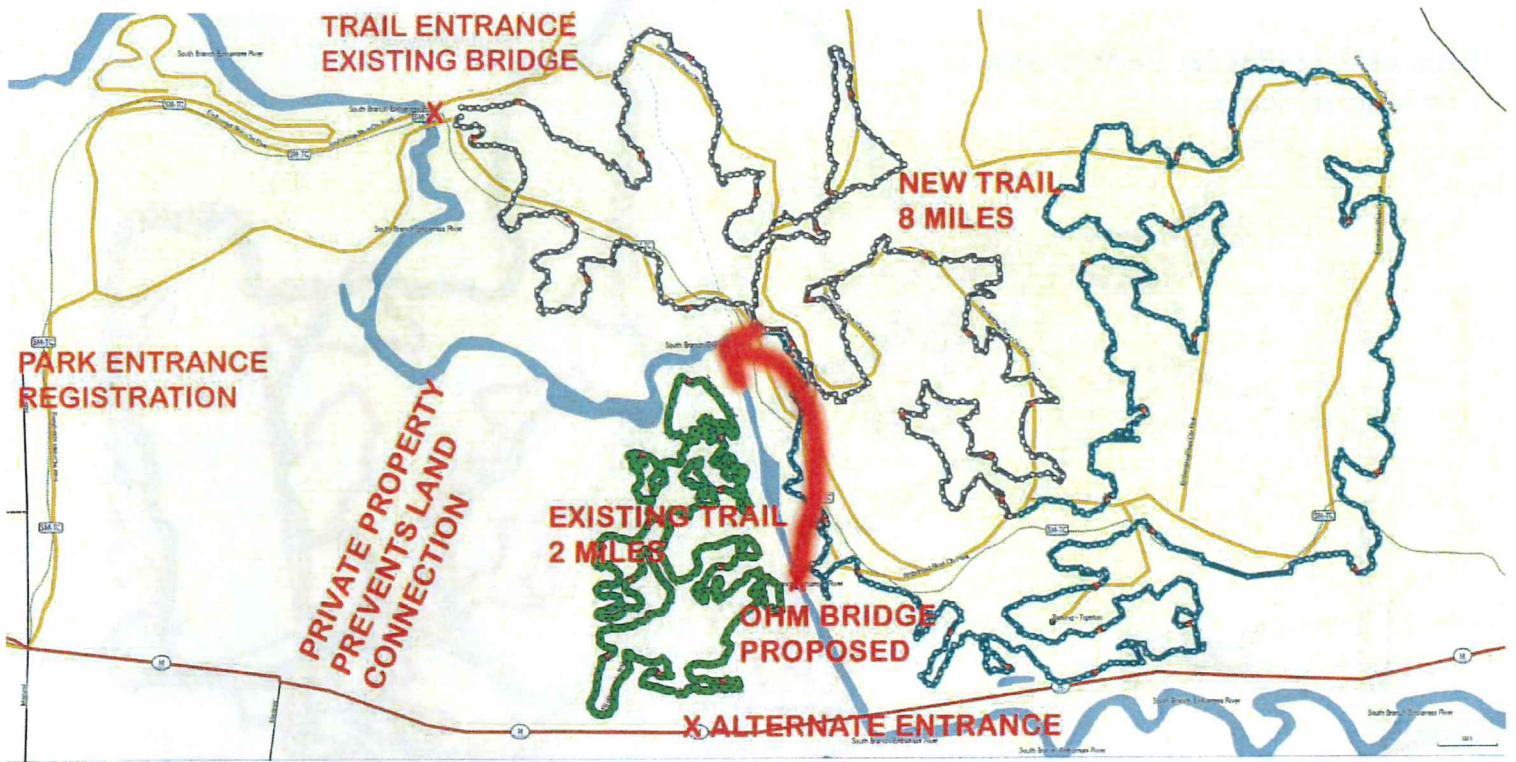
