The cutting area is approximately 195 acres.

The contract period is 2 years.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter chosen by the bidder will be cut and utilized.

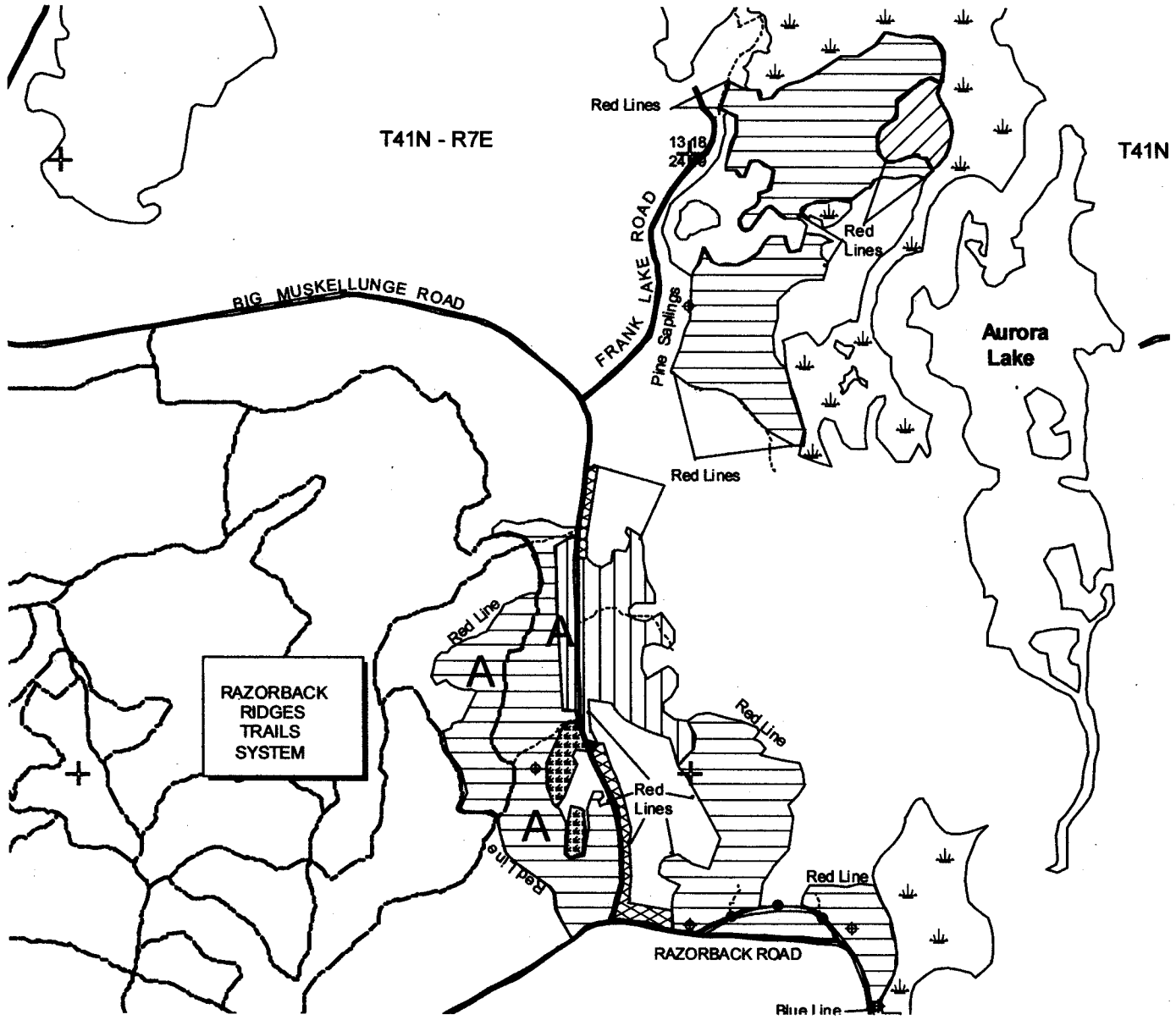
¹Volume includes 53% white birch, 32% red maple, 14% red oak, and 1% sugar maple.

²Volume includes 34% balsam fir, 26% scotch pine, 17% spruce, 17% white pine, and 6% jack pine.

Special Conditions:

1. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested. Harvesting in the low ground areas will only be allowed during dry or frozen ground conditions.⁽⁹⁾
2. Harvesting activities in Zone A will be permitted from April 1 – December 1⁽¹³⁾
3. Slash within 50 feet of all town roads and the Razorback ski trails must be lopped and/or scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and pulled back at least ten feet behind the tree line concurrent with cutting. No tops or slash allowed across any red line, blue line, or in any open swamp. All trails must be kept open and free of debris at all times.⁽¹⁵⁾
4. All landings and any new woods roads must be approved prior to sale start up. Decking, skidding, and hauling along the Razorback trails will be determined prior to sale start up. All wood decked on any ski trail must be removed before the start of each ski season. All trails must be restored to pre-harvest condition before the start of each ski season and upon sale completion.⁽¹⁷⁾
5. All conifer products cut between June 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Conifer products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to June 1 of each year.⁽³²⁾

- Main Sale Area (153 Acres):** Cut all aspen, white birch, maple, jack pine, scotch pine, balsam fir & spruce (with at least 2 sticks) and all orange marked trees. Cut all 1-5 inch aspen.
- Red Pine Area (29 Acres):** Same prescription as above.
- Northern Hardwood Area (7 Acres):** Cut all aspen, white birch, and orange marked trees.
- Leave Tree Area (6 Acres):** Cut all trees except red pine, white pine, and green marked trees.
