10% of the total sale bid value will be required as bid bond.

15% of the total sale bid value will be required for performance bond.

The cutting area is approximately 130 acres.

The contract period is 2 years.

All trees within the aspen regeneration areas that yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter chosen by the bidder will be cut and utilized. Within the hardwood thinning areas all aspen, white birch, balsam fir and black spruce that yield 100-inch sticks will be cut and utilized.

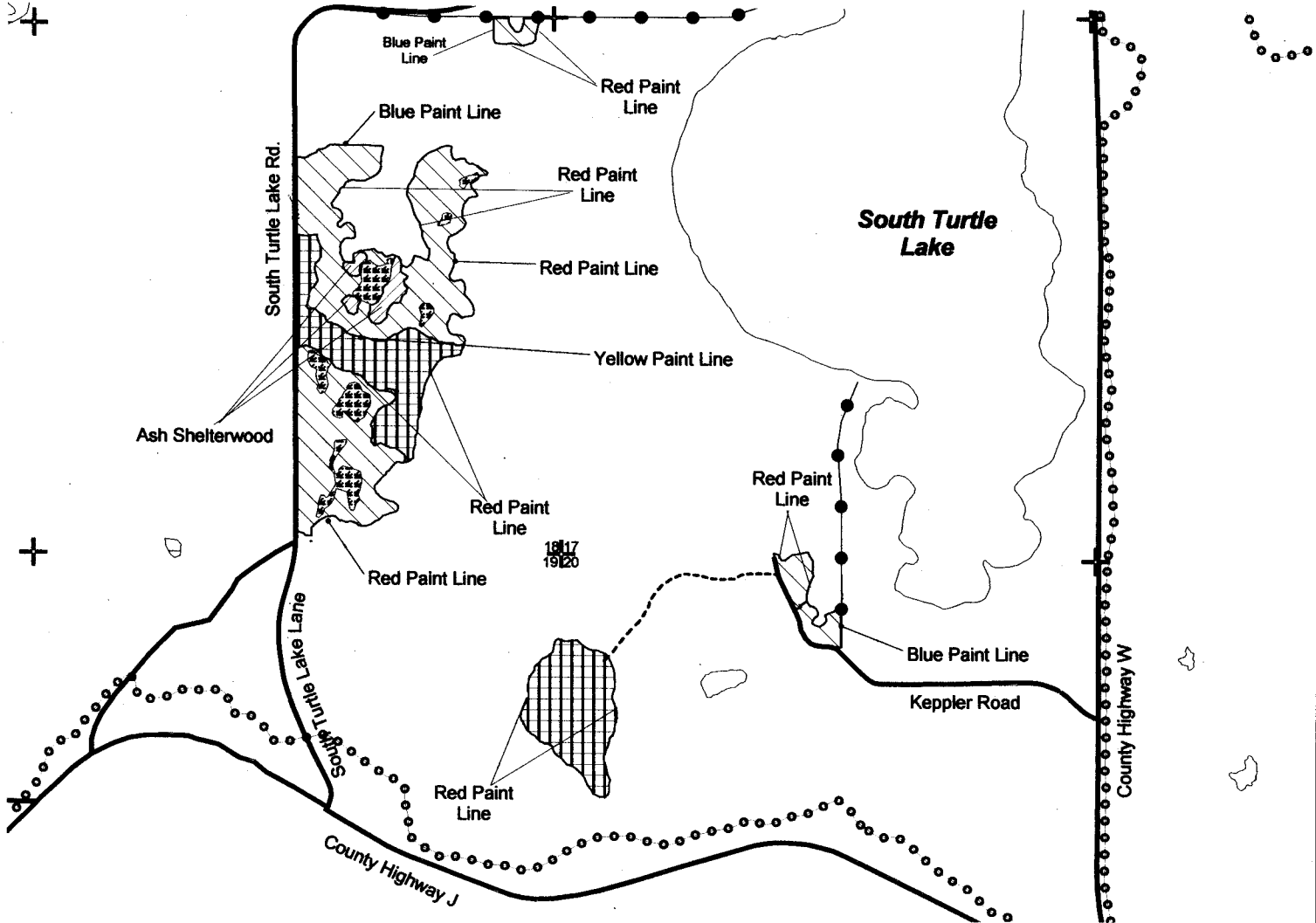

Special Conditions:




1. Harvesting will only be permitted during winter months and frozen ground. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested.
2. Slash within 50 feet of all Town roads must be lopped and/or scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and pulled back at least ten feet behind the tree line concurrent with cutting. No tops or slash allowed across any red line or in any open swamp or wetland slew.⁽¹⁵⁾
3. All landings and any new woods roads must be approved prior to sale start up.
4. All conifer products must be removed from the sale area prior to June 1 of each year.⁽³²⁾
5. Equipment Restrictions: Skidding of forest product materials will be restricted to shortwood skidders only.

-  Aspen Regeneration Areas (80 Acres): Cut all aspen, white birch, and other hardwoods down to 2 inches. Cut all fir and black spruce down to 1-stick. Leave all cedar, hemlock, yellow birch and white and red pine. Leave all white spruce except those identified by with the word cut in orange paint.
-  Ash Shelterwood (4 Acres): Cut all trees except black ash marked with green paint.
-  Hardwood Thinning (46 Acres): Cut all aspen, white birch and all trees marked with orange paint. Cut all balsam fir down to 1-stick.

Note: Do NOT cut trees marked with green paint.
