Town 41 North, Range 8 East

Section 23 – NENW, SWNW, SENW, NWSW, SWSW, SESE

Section 26 – NE ¼, NWNW, SENW, NWSE

Section 27 – NENE, SENE

Section 28 – SWNW, SENW, NWSE

10% of the total sale bid value will be required as bid bond.

15% of the total sale bid value will be required for performance bond.

The cutting area is approximately 176 acres.

The contract period is 2 years.

Except in the White Pine Release areas, all trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter chosen by the bidder will be cut and utilized. Within the White Pine Release harvest area, cut only those balsam fir containing three or more sticks.

<sup>4</sup>Approximately 65% black spruce, 30% Norway spruce and 7% white spruce

Special Conditions:

1. Cable skidding is recommended due to topography.
2. Harvesting in the lowland areas will only be allowed during dry or frozen ground conditions.(9)

- White Pine Release (20 Acres): Harvest all oak, maple, and 3-stick balsam fir UNLESS marked with green paint. Cutting of 1-5" trees is not required. Minimize damage to white pine understory. Do not cut hemlock, white pine or red pine.
- Hardwood Regeneration (141 Acres): Cut all aspen, birch, maple, jack pine, fir, tamarack, black spruce and trees marked with orange paint. Cut all 1-5" red maple and fir, except within 50' of CTH N or Wharton Lake Road. Cutting in lowland areas is only allowed during dry or frozen conditions.
- Red Pine Thinning (15 Acres): Cut all aspen, birch, maple and trees marked with orange paint

**Note: Do NOT cut trees marked with green paint.**
