Section 28 – NESW, NWSW

Section 34 – SWNW, SENW, NESW, NWSE, SWSE, SESE

10% of the total sale bid value will be required as bid bond.

The cutting area is approximately 139 acres.

The contract period is 2 years.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter chosen by the bidder will be cut and utilized.

¹Mixed Hardwood includes approximately 73% red maple and 27% white birch.

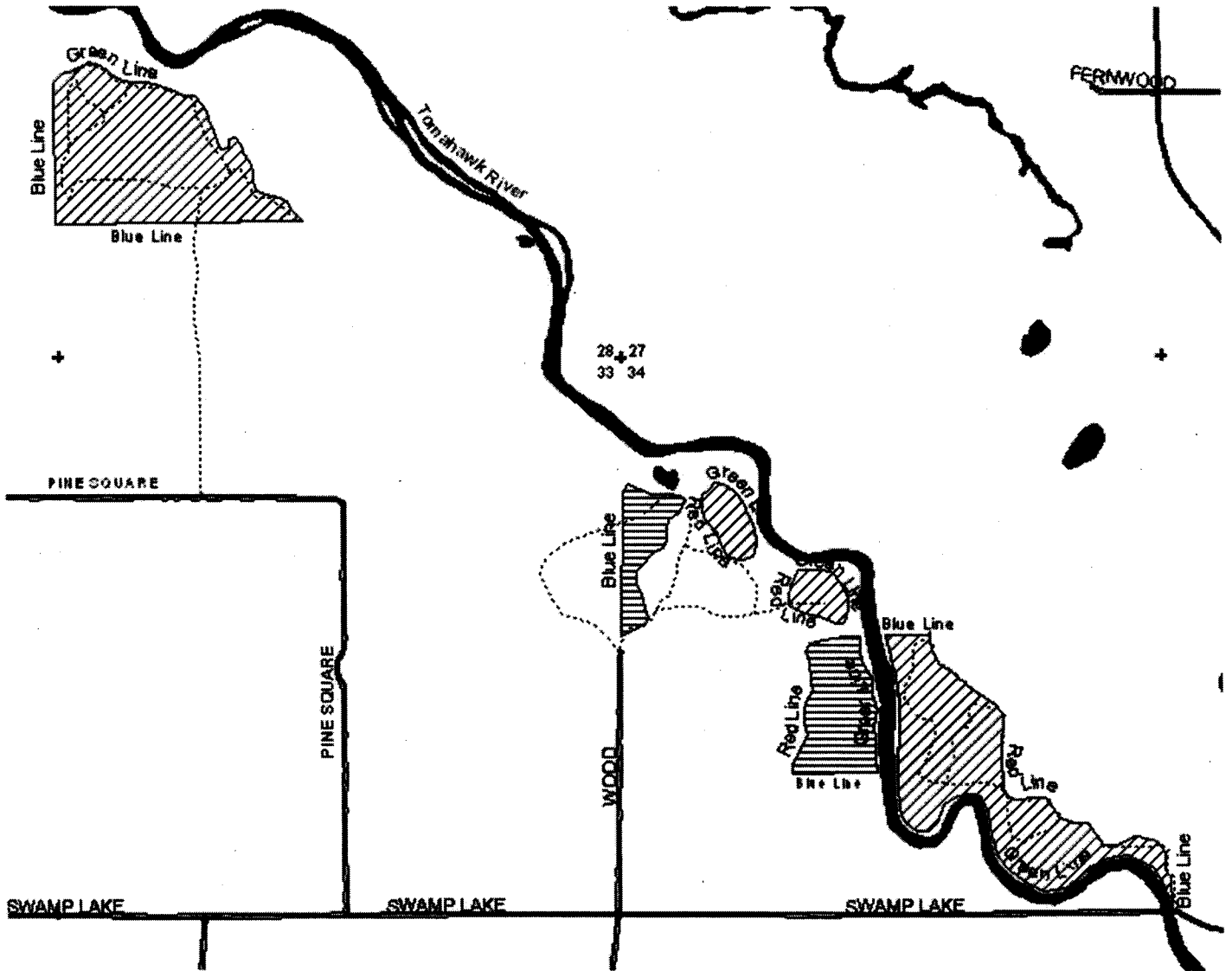
²Red Pine includes approximately 55% red pine, 28 % jack pine, and 17% white pine.

³White Pine includes approximately 60% white pine and 40% red pine.

Special Conditions:

1. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested. ⁽⁹⁾
2. All sale activity permitted between September 1st and April 1st ⁽¹⁾
3. All landings require prior approval. ⁽¹⁷⁾
4. All trails and roads must be kept clear of slash and in driveable condition. ⁽¹⁷⁾
5. Felling and skidding damage to residual trees, including understory pine regeneration, must be avoided.
6. Forestry Best Management Practices (BMPs) must be followed in areas adjacent to streams and wetlands.
 - A. Trees may not be felled into wetland/swamp areas.
 - B. A 50 foot 'no equipment zone' is designated by a green line along the river.
7. All roads must be returned to their original condition. ⁽¹⁷⁾
8. Slash must be lopped and scattered to lie within 2 feet of the ground. ⁽¹⁵⁾
