All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to a minimum 4” top diameter will be cut and utilized.

¹Approximately 50% red maple, 30% oak, 15% hard maple, 5% white birch and less than 1% ironwood.

²Approximately 90% spruce, 5% white pine, 5% red pine, and less than 1% balsam fir and jack pine.

³Approximately 85% red pine and 15% white pine.

Special Conditions

1. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested.⁽⁹⁾
2. Slash within 50’ of Town roads must be lopped and/or scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and pulled back at least ten feet behind the tree line concurrently with cutting. ⁽¹⁵⁾
3. Decking will be permitted along the snowmobile trail only when the trails are not in use. Wood decked on the snowmobile trail must be removed before the start of each snowmobile season (Trails normally open December 10th). All trails must be repaired to pre-harvest conditions before the start of each snow season.⁽¹⁷⁾
4. Access through the prison camp sawmill and W. Two Lakes Road is restricted. All hauling must take place out to Highway D through State land and route indicated on map.
