Special Conditions

1. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested. <sup>(9)</sup>
2. Slash must be lopped and/scattered to lie within two feet of the ground. No tops or slash allowed across any blue line, or in any lowland grass area. <sup>(15)</sup>
3. All landings and any new roads must be approved by the timber sale administrator. All roads must be repaired to original or better than original condition. <sup>(17)</sup>
4. Harvest on dry or frozen ground only. All harvest activities and hauling will cease prior to any rutting occurring. <sup>(35)</sup>

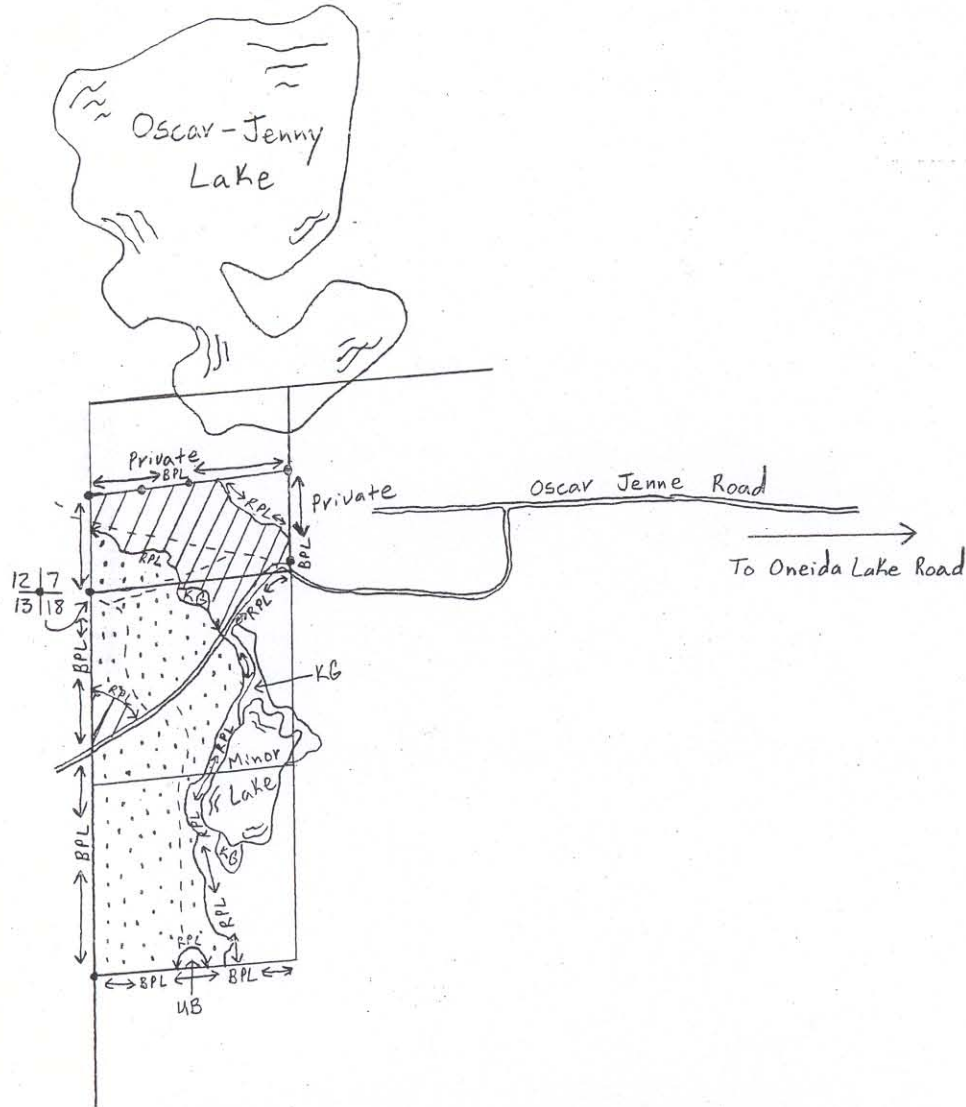

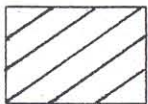

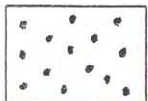

**ASPEN REGENERATION AREA (17 acres)**, cut all trees greater than 2 inches in diameter except for all spruce, pine, red oak, and aspen marked with green paint. Utilization is 100" stick to a 4" top.



**OAK THINNING AREA (50 acres)**, cut all aspen, white birch, and trees marked with orange paint on the trunk and stump. **Do not cut** any white birch trees marked with green paint. **Do not cut** any yellow birch. Damage to residual trees will not be tolerated. Utilization is 100" stick to a 4" top.
