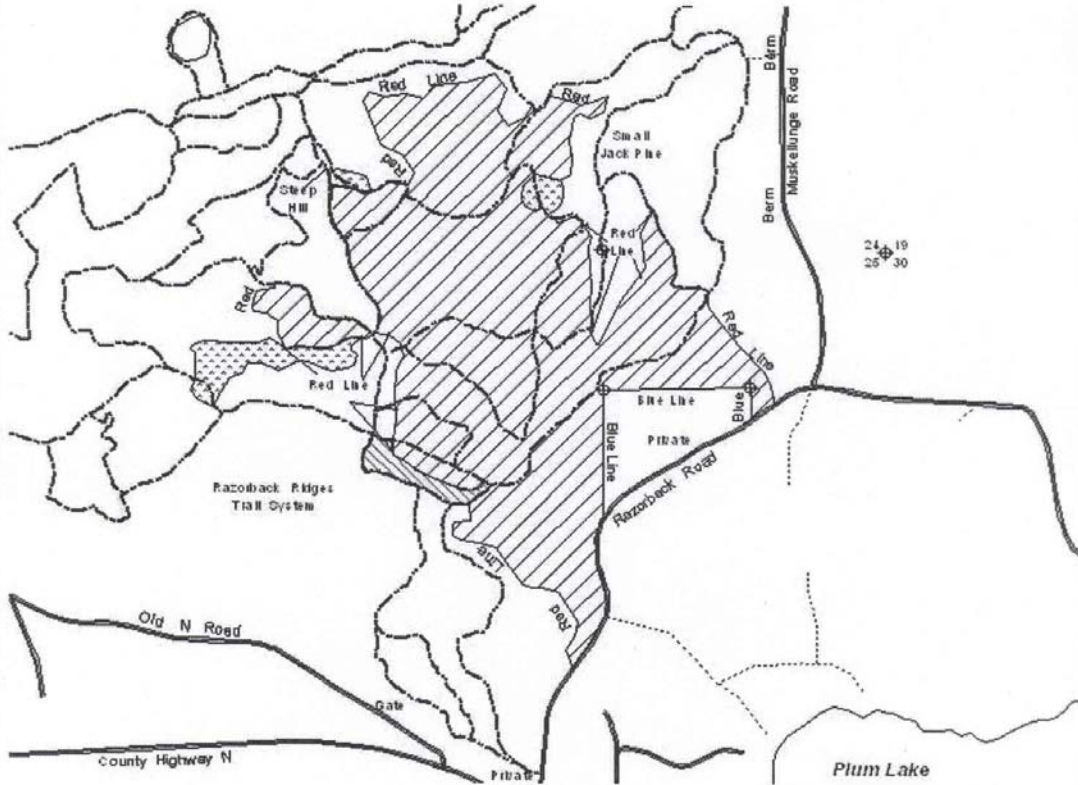

Special Conditions:

1. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested. Pole skidding WILL NOT be permitted on this sale. All sale activity, including hauling, will be permitted from **April 1-December 1 ONLY**.⁽⁹⁾
2. Slash within 50 feet of all roads and recreational trails must be lopped and/or scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and pulled back at least ten feet behind the tree line concurrent with cutting. All slash must be pulled back at least 10 feet from any recreational trail. Trails will be kept open and passable at all times. No tops or slash allowed across any red line, blue line, grass opening, or in any wetland.⁽¹⁶⁾
3. All landings and any new woods roads must be approved prior to sale start up. Skidding and decking will be permitted along certain recreational trails with prior approval. All wood decked on any recreational trail must be removed by Dec. 1 during every year of the contract. All recreational trails must be restored to **pre-harvest condition** before Dec. 1 of each ski season and upon sale completion.⁽¹⁸⁾
4. All conifer products cut between June 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Conifer products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to June 1 of each year.⁽³⁵⁾
