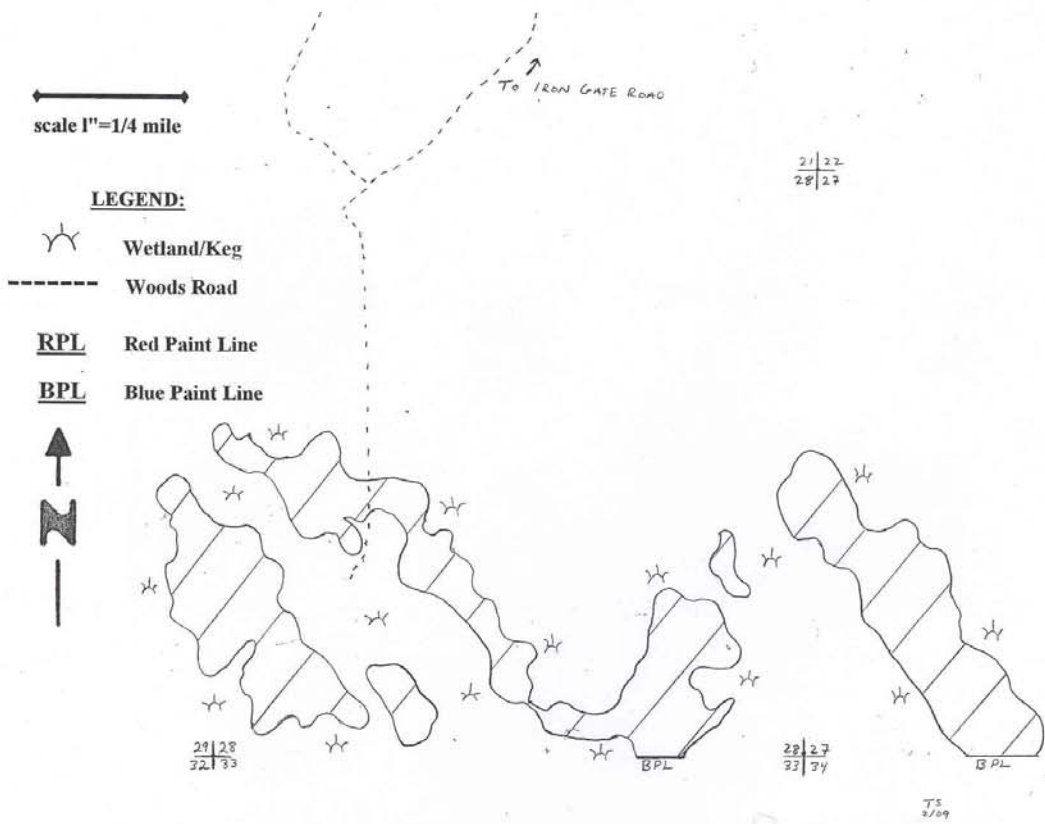

<sup>1</sup>Mixed Hardwood (4") includes approximately 67% red maple and 33% white birch.


Special Conditions:

1. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested. (9)
2. All sale activity permitted during frozen or dry conditions only. (35)
3. All landings require prior approval. (18)
4. All trails and roads must be kept clear of slash and in driveable condition. (18)
5. Felling and skidding damage to residual trees must be avoided. (9)
6. Forestry Best Management Practices (BMPs) must be followed in areas adjacent to wetlands.(18)
  - A. No landings or new skid roads permitted within 100' of wetland's edge.
  - B. Trees may not be felled into wetland/swamp areas.
7. All roads must be returned to their original condition. (18)
8. Slash must be lopped and scattered to lie within 2 feet of the ground. (16)

**(146 acres) Aspen Area:** Cut all aspen, birch, maple, and balsam fir (including all 1" – 5" stems). Cut only those pines marked with orange paint. Do not cut spruce, tamarack, or cedar.
