All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter chosen by the bidder will be cut and utilized.

Special Conditions:

1. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested. No tree length or pole skidding allowed. No cutting will be permitted between April 1 and July 31.⁽⁹⁾
2. Slash must be lopped and scattered to lie within two feet of the ground. No tops or slash allowed across any blue line, or in any swamp.⁽¹⁶⁾
3. All landings and any new roads must be approved by the timber sale administrator. All roads must be repaired to original or better than original condition.⁽¹⁸⁾
4. All cutting to be done when the ground is frozen or dry. Leave all the standing dead trees that are not a safety hazard.⁽³⁵⁾

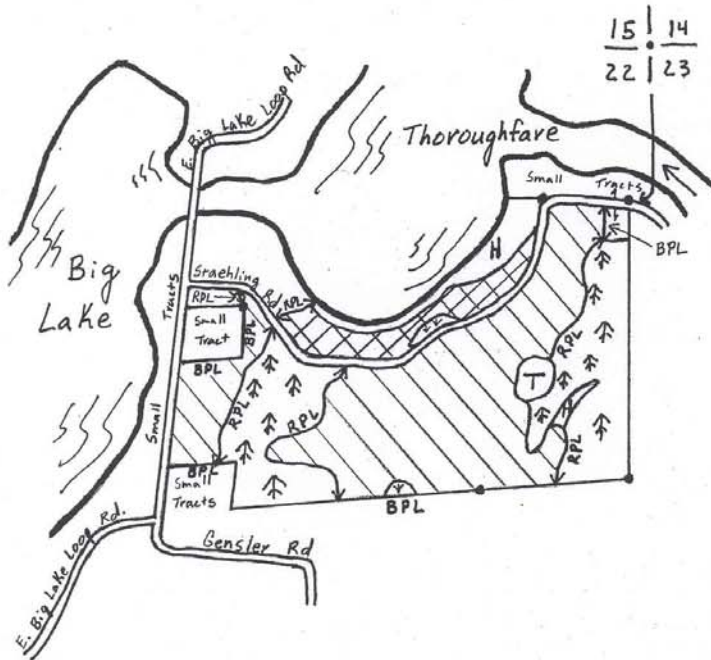

Marked Hardwood (97 acres):

1. Cut all merchantable aspen, white birch, balsam fir, and trees marked with orange paint.
2. **Do not cut** any aspen marked with green paint.
3. Within the **Yellow Circle Canopy Gaps**, cut all trees greater than 1 inch in diameter within the gaps, including all trees marked yellow.

Aesthetic Area (9 acres):

1. Cut all trees marked with orange paint and all balsam fir.
2. **Do not cut** any aspen or birch unless marked with orange paint.

*No cutting permitted between April 1 and July 31.

***Do not damage any hemlock** regeneration (especially in the aesthetic area).

*Take care not to damage maple regeneration.
