Potential Impacts of Global Warming Solutions

- Negative:
 - Higher transportation fuel prices (gasoline)
 - Higher electricity prices (and natural gas)
 - Pass-through of transportation costs into consumer good prices

 - Role of fixed costs?

Potential Impacts of Global Warming Solutions

- Positive:
 - Household energy savings
 - Heating
 - Electric
 - Appliances
 - Distributed generation
 - Gasoline savings
 - Transit
 - Land use
 - Vehicle efficiency
 - Long Term
 - Reduction of pollution impacts (environmental justice)

How do we make it better? (short term)

- Gasoline costs
 - Transit assistance
- Electric costs
 - Energy bill assistance – tie to efficiency?
 - Weatherization Programs
 - Focus on Energy

How do we make it better? (longer term)

- Gasoline costs
 - Transit coverage in low-income areas
 - Maintaining/decreasing transit fares
 - Reward reduction of SOV miles
 - Ex: PAYD Insurance
- Electric costs
 - Conservation rate structure
 - Large scale retrofit programs
 - Split incentive

- Appliances
- Vehicles
- Buildings – Efficiency and Renewables
 - Overcoming the split incentive
 - Financing
 - PAYS
 - Berkeley solar model
 - POS upgrades
 - Enforce existing code

Jobs

- Capture the benefits for Low-income Communities
 - Labor standards
 - Best Value Contracting standards
 - 10% apprenticeship utilization requirement.
 - 10 % community hire requirement (10 miles)
 - Workforce outreach and development
 - Regionally specific
 - Partnerships - involve businesses, labor, tech colleges, etc
 - entry-level training (soft skills) for low-skill workers to specific hard skill training for incumbent and dislocated workers
