10% of the total sale bid value will be required as bid bond.

15% of the total sale bid value will be required for performance bond.

The cutting area is approximately 87 acres.

The contract period is for a 2 winter period, from December 15 - April 1, or while ground is frozen.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter chosen by the bidder will be cut and utilized.

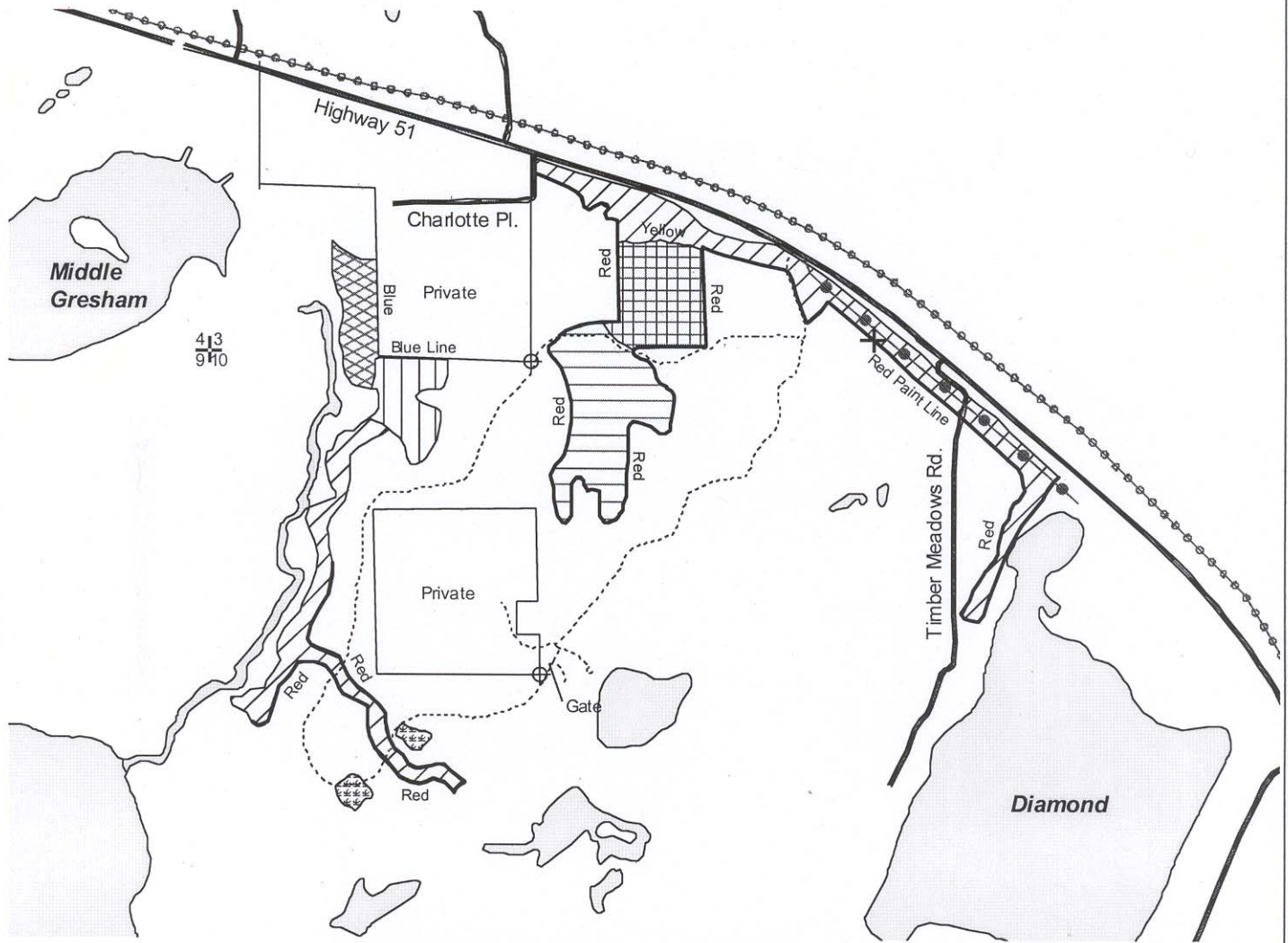

Special Conditions:

1. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested. In the swamp conifer and black spruce part of the sale harvesting will only be allowed during frozen ground conditions from December 15 – April 1.⁽⁹⁾
2. No tops or slash allowed across any blue line.⁽¹⁶⁾
3. Slash in the black spruce area should be scattered evenly across the harvested spruce area.⁽¹⁶⁾
4. Wildlife openings may not be used for decking wood.⁽¹⁸⁾
5. All landings and any new woods roads must be approved prior to sale start up.⁽¹⁸⁾

- Conifer Swamp (8 Acres): Cut all merchantable ash, balsam fir, white birch, spruce and aspen. Harvest only during frozen ground conditions.
- Aesthetic Area (39 Acres): Cut all aspen, trees marked with orange paint and standing dead oak. Avoid damage to white pine regeneration.
- Oak Shelterwood Area (13 Acres): Cut all maple, including all 1 to 5 inch maple. Cut all trees marked with orange paint. Do NOT cut aspen, unless marked with orange paint.
- Oak Regen Area (20 Acres): Cut all trees, including all 1 to 5 inch trees, EXCEPT aspen and green marked trees.
- Spruce Swamp (7 Acres): Cut all spruce and tamarack, EXCEPT for the blue painted boundary and green marked trees. Harvest only during frozen ground conditions.
