

FSC Highly Hazardous Pesticides – 2009

Following are products prohibited for use on lands certified by the Forest Stewardship Council (FSC). Landowners and land managers should not apply the listed products unless a variance (derogation) has been formally approved by the FSC Board of Directors. As of May 2009, there are no FSC variances for use of prohibited pesticides in Wisconsin.

Knowing what commercial products contain the banned chemicals can be challenging. The following table has a few examples of brand names, but there might be hundreds. You can use a web database provided by the Pesticide Action Network of North America to determine if any products in your process are affected:

To use this tool:

1. Enter the chemical name (copy and paste from the FSC list) and click “search”
2. Under detailed information, click “More”
3. On the new page, scroll down to “View U.S. Products” (but first click the radio button for “currently registered products”). You’ll be presented with all the trade name products in the US market that contain the chemical.
