

## **FSC Highly Hazardous Pesticides - 2007**

Following are products prohibited for use on lands certified by the Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) unless a normal derogation or a temporary exceptional derogation for use has been formally approved by the FSC Board of Directors. (Wisconsin DNR State Forests and County Forests have an approved derogation for the use of Hexazinone.)

Knowing what commercial products contain the banned chemicals can be challenging. The following table has a few examples of brand names, but there might be hundreds. You can use a web database provided by the Pesticide Action Network of North America to determine if any products in your process are affected:

To use this tool:

1. Enter the chemical name (copy and paste from the FSC list) and click “search”
2. Under detailed information, click “More”
3. On the new page, scroll down to “View U.S. Products” (but first click the radio button for “currently registered products”). You’ll be presented with all the trade name products in the US market that contain the chemical.
