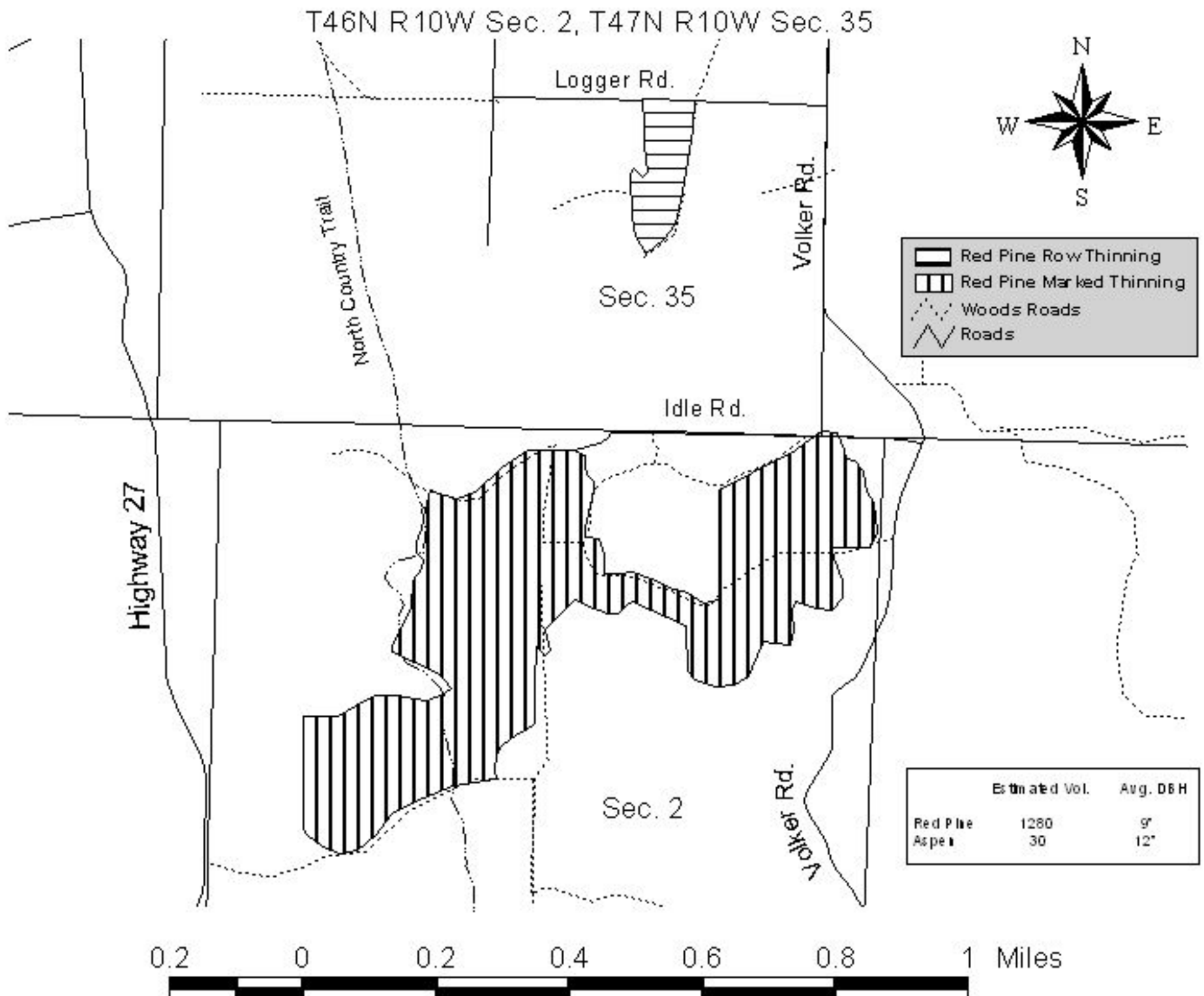


Brule River State Forest

Pine Hole Sale - Tract 06-07 - 127 acres



1. Marked Thinning:
 - a. Harvest all marked trees within the sale boundary.
 - b. Utilize all harvested trees that contain one 100" stick to a 4" diameter top.
 - c. All aspen greater than 8" dbh are to be harvested and utilized to a 4" diameter top.
 - c. All other trees are to remain uncut and undamaged.
2. Row Thinning:
 - a. The harvest pattern for this part of the sale is every other row is to be removed.
 - b. All harvested trees that contain one 100" stick to a 4" diameter top are to be utilized.
 - c. Outside rows remain intact.
 - d. Remaining trees are to be left uncut and undamaged.
3. Between May 15 and August 15 all harvested pine products must be hauled from the site within 2 weeks of felling to prevent bark beetle infestation.
4. All trees must be limbed and bucked at the stump. Damage to the residual stand will not be allowed.
5. Steep grades are present on some parts of the sale.
6. Existing roadways will be used. New road construction must be approved by BRSF staff.
7. The North Country Trail runs through part of this sale. The trail is not to be used by machinery for travel. Any damage done to the trail must be repaired.
8. Slash will be evenly distributed across the site.
9. Minimum Bid: \$32,200.00
