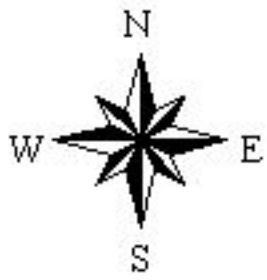
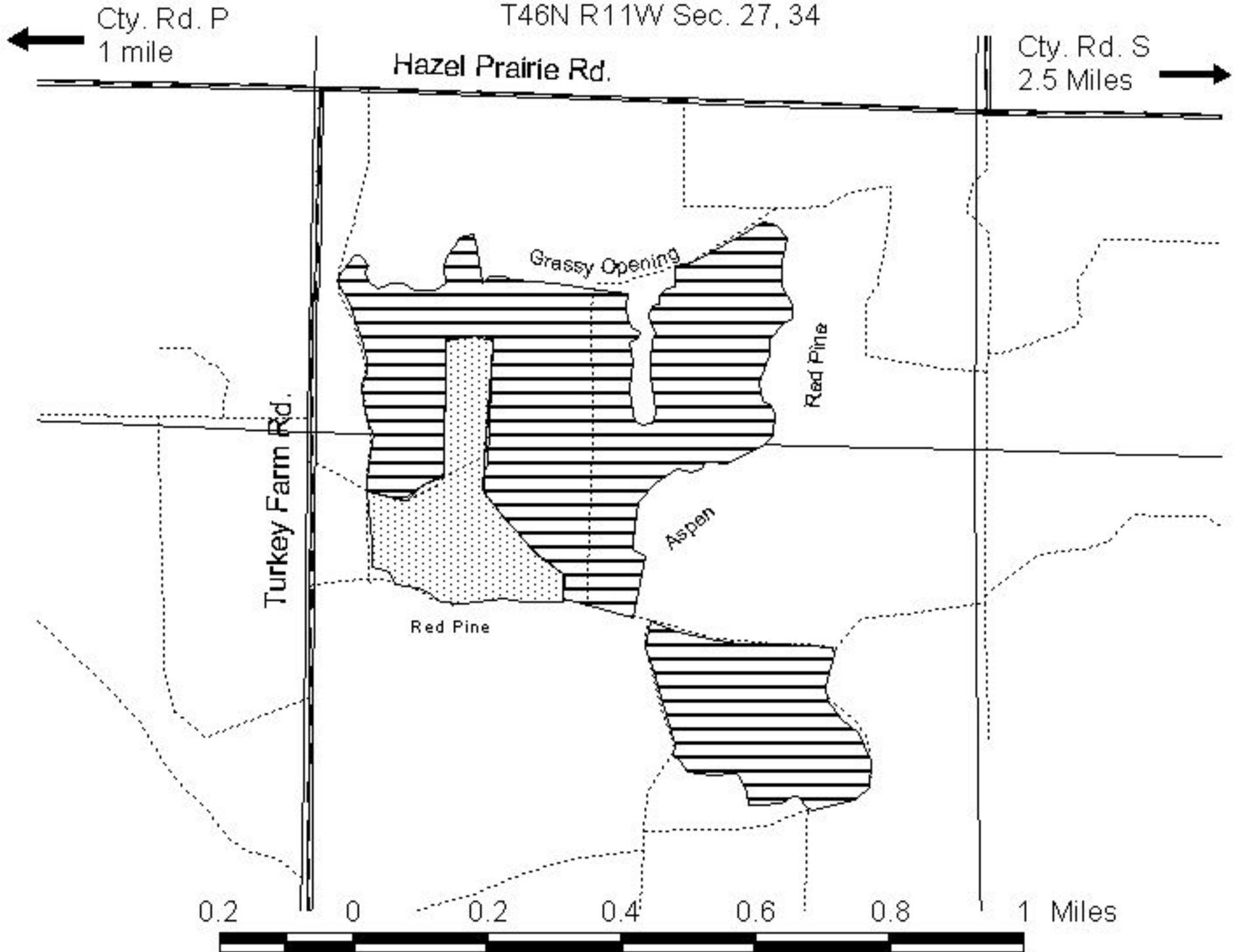

-  **Section Lines**

1. Row Thinning:
 - a. Cut every other row leaving the outside rows intact.
 - b. If there is a space of 30 feet or greater in an adjacent row to a cut row that area is to be used for travel.
2. Marked Area:
 - a. Remove all trees from the marked thinning area.
 - Trees marked with angled slashes are individual trees
 - Trees marked with large vertical slashes are designated for that entire row to be removed.
 - b. A blue/green line designates the boundary between marked and row thinning areas.
3. Damage to the residual stand will not be allowed.
4. All harvested trees containing one or more 100" stick to a 4" top diameter are to be utilized.
5. Between May 15 and August 15 all pine products must be hauled from the site within two weeks of harvest to prevent bark beetle infestation.
6. Existing roads are to be used, new road construction must be approved by BRSF staff.
7. Harvest may take place at any time of the year.
8. Minimum bid: \$83,750.00
