¹Mixed pulp is approx. 50% hard maple, 20% red maple, 10% ash, 14% yellow birch, 6% cherry and other.

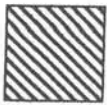
²Misc. saw is approx. 10% hard maple, 15% red maple, 45% basswood, 12% ash, and 18% yellow birch.

The bid bond will be \$1,000.00. This will also be used as the performance bond. Contract length is approximately one year.

SPECIAL SALE CONDITIONS:

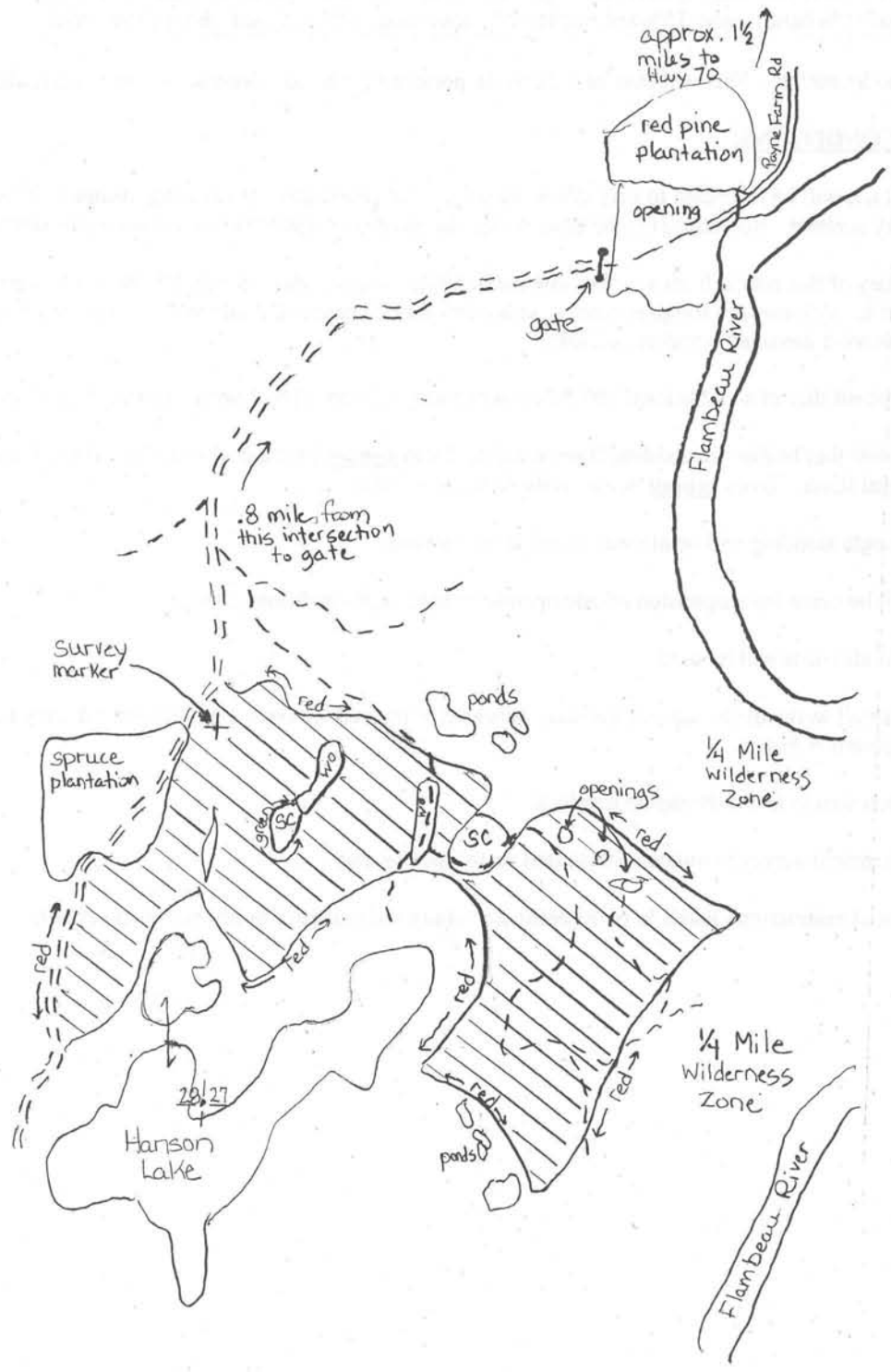
1. Equipment use will be restricted to very dry or frozen ground conditions. **No rutting allowed.** This sale should be able to be cut during a dry summer. No cutting can be done during the months of April, May and June in the select cut area.
2. The boundary of this sale is from a timber sale cut in 2003. A wind storm in July of 2006 hit this area and left scattered wind damage through out it. Volumes are rough estimates, so bidders should inspect the sale area. The main objective is to harvest and utilize as much of the wind damaged wood as possible.
3. There is a possibility of an additional 10% of trees that may be marked by Forester during harvesting operations.
4. There is a 400-foot buffer surrounding Hanson Lake. Trees **cannot** be cut in this buffer. There is also a ¼ Mile Wilderness area along the Flambeau River. Trees **cannot** be cut in the Wilderness area.
5. No pole length skidding will be allowed in the select cut area.
6. Rutting will be cause for suspension of sale operations until such conditions change.
7. Existing woods roads will be used.
8. Watch for small wetlands throughout the sale. Wheeled or tracked harvesting equipment will only operate within 15 feet of wetlands when the ground is frozen.
9. Care will be taken to avoid damaging hemlock.
10. Avoid government survey monument illustrated on prospectus map.
11. **All additional restrictions listed in prospectus and standard contract apply unless specified.**

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Select Cut Area (139 acres) – Bounded by red paint lines. Harvest all wind damaged trees. A wind damaged tree is defined as any tree that is leaning 45 degrees or more including down trees, whose main bole is split or broken, or whose roots are sprung.
