SPECIAL SALE CONDITIONS:

- Equipment use will be restricted to very dry or frozen ground conditions due to wet soil conditions. Some areas of the sale are restricted to frozen conditions only. **No rutting allowed.** General operational period will most likely be December through March. No cutting can be done during the months of April, May and June in the select cut area.
- No pole length skidding will be allowed in the select cut area.
- Slash that is within 100 feet of County Rd. EE shall be lopped and scattered to within 2 feet of the ground by the contractor.
- Contractor is required to close roads at the locations designated on the map by placing either berms or logging debris, per sale prospectus.
- Existing woods roads will be used. Although new stub road construction is needed, it is limited to proposed road layout shown on prospectus map. Due to topography and or drainage patterns new roads will be laid out by State Forest staff.
- No slash or logging debris will be left across the blue line onto the Chequamegon National Forest.
- Avoid government survey monument illustrated on prospectus map.
- All additional restrictions listed in the prospectus and standard contract apply unless specified.**

Harvest all orange marked trees within the designated boundaries.
Sever all orange marked unmerchantable stems (canopy gaps).
Harvest all merchantable balsam fir.
