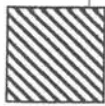

The bid bond will be 15% of the total sale value. This will also be used as the performance bond. Contract length is approximately two years.

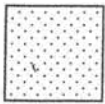
SPECIAL SALE CONDITIONS:

1. Equipment use will be restricted to very dry or frozen ground conditions due to wet soil conditions. No cutting can be done during the months of April, May and June in the select cut area.
2. Existing woods roads will be used. New road construction is optional, and is limited to proposed road layout shown on prospectus map.
3. Cutting will not be allowed in the Birch area until scarification is completed by WDNR. Harvest shall be completed within one year of scarification.
4. Contractor is required to close road at the location designated on the map by placing logging debris, per sale prospectus.
5. Pole skidding will be allowed only in aspen area.
6. Wheeled or tracked harvesting equipment will only operate within 15 feet of wetlands when the ground is frozen or dry.
7. Watch for small wetlands throughout the sale. No slash is to be left in any non-forested wetland.
8. The northern 1/3 of sale has moderate to extreme slopes.
9. Culverts may be needed. Culvert placement and removal are the responsibility of the contractor.
10. **All additional restrictions listed in the prospectus and standard contract apply unless specified.**

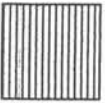
Sale Tract 14-06 (Spring Beauty)



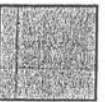
Select cut Area (117 acres) – Bounded by red paint lines. Harvest orange marked trees within the designated boundaries. Do not cut trees with an orange “X”. These are leave trees.



Aspen Area (18 acres) – Bounded by yellow. Cut all trees greater than 2” except for: 1) hemlock, 2) white pine, and 3) oak. Approx. 10 acres has some wind damage.

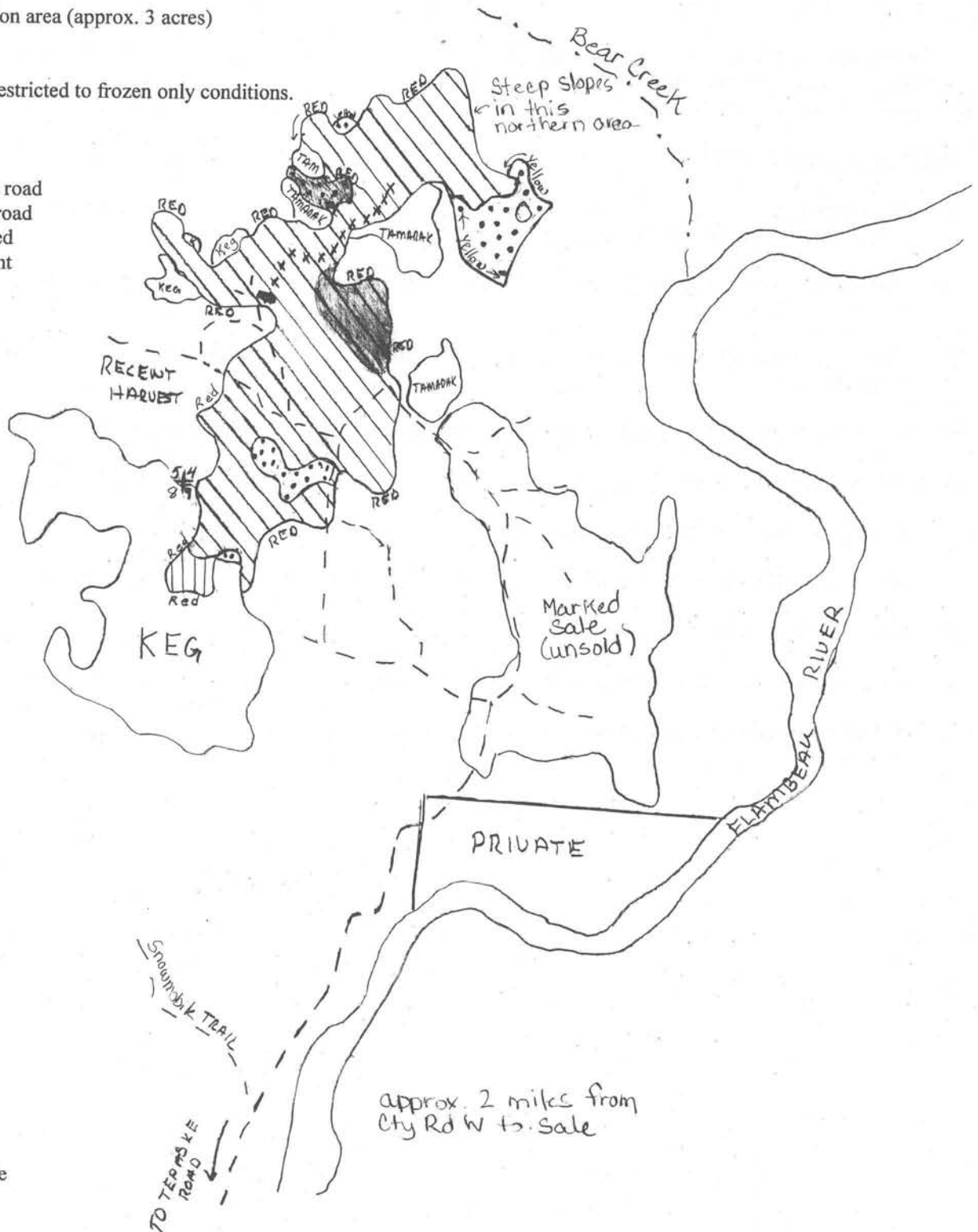


Birch Scarification area (approx. 3 acres)
