

The bid bond will be 15% of the total sale value. This will also be used as the performance bond. Contract length is approximately two years.

**SPECIAL SALE CONDITIONS:**

1. Equipment use will be restricted to very dry or frozen ground conditions due to wet soil conditions. **No rutting allowed.** General operational period will most likely be December through March. No cutting can be done during the months of April, May and June in the select cut area.
2. No pole length skidding will be allowed in the select cut area.
3. This sale area has steep terrain throughout it.
4. New road construction and landings must be approved by Forester. Any decking on Flambeau Road must have prior written approval from the Town of Cedar Rapids.
5. Slash along Flambeau Road will be pulled back 10' and be treated to lay 2' within 100 feet of the road.
6. Care will be taken to avoid damaging hemlock.
7. Aspen is not designated; **cut only marked aspen stems.**
8. **All additional restrictions listed in prospectus and standard contract apply unless specified.**

 Select Cut Area (43 acres) – Bounded by red paint lines. Harvest all trees marked with orange paint (leave snag/cull trees marked with orange X). **Sever all orange marked unmerchantable stems (canopy gaps).** Harvest only marked aspen.
