The bid bond will be 15% of the total sale value. This will also be used as the performance bond. Contract length is approximately two years.

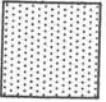
**SPECIAL SALE CONDITIONS:**

1. Equipment use will be restricted to very dry or frozen ground conditions due to wet soil conditions. Sale area accessed through Sale #645 is **frozen only** due to requirements of the study area. Some other areas will also need frozen conditions. General operational period will most likely be December through March. No cutting can be done during the months of April, May and June in the select cut area.
2. No pole length skidding will be allowed in the select cut area.
3. The existing woods road within Sale #645 may need to be shared if both sales are active at the same time. No additional road work or improvements will be allowed on this road or within the study area.
4. Existing woods roads will be used. New road construction must be approved by Forester.
5. Decking along Hervas Road is permitted.
6. Slash that is within 100 feet of Hervas Road will be lopped and scattered to within 2 feet of the ground by contractor. No slash or logging debris will be left across the blue line onto Rusk County Forest land.
7. This tract borders and has numerous wetlands with softer areas adjacent to them. No slash is to be left in any non-forested wetland, open water, or designated stream channel.
8. Care will be taken to avoid damaging hemlock.
9. Protect all survey monuments.
10. Contractor is required to close roads at the locations designated on the map by placing logging debris.
11. **All additional restrictions listed in the prospectus and standard contract apply unless specified.**

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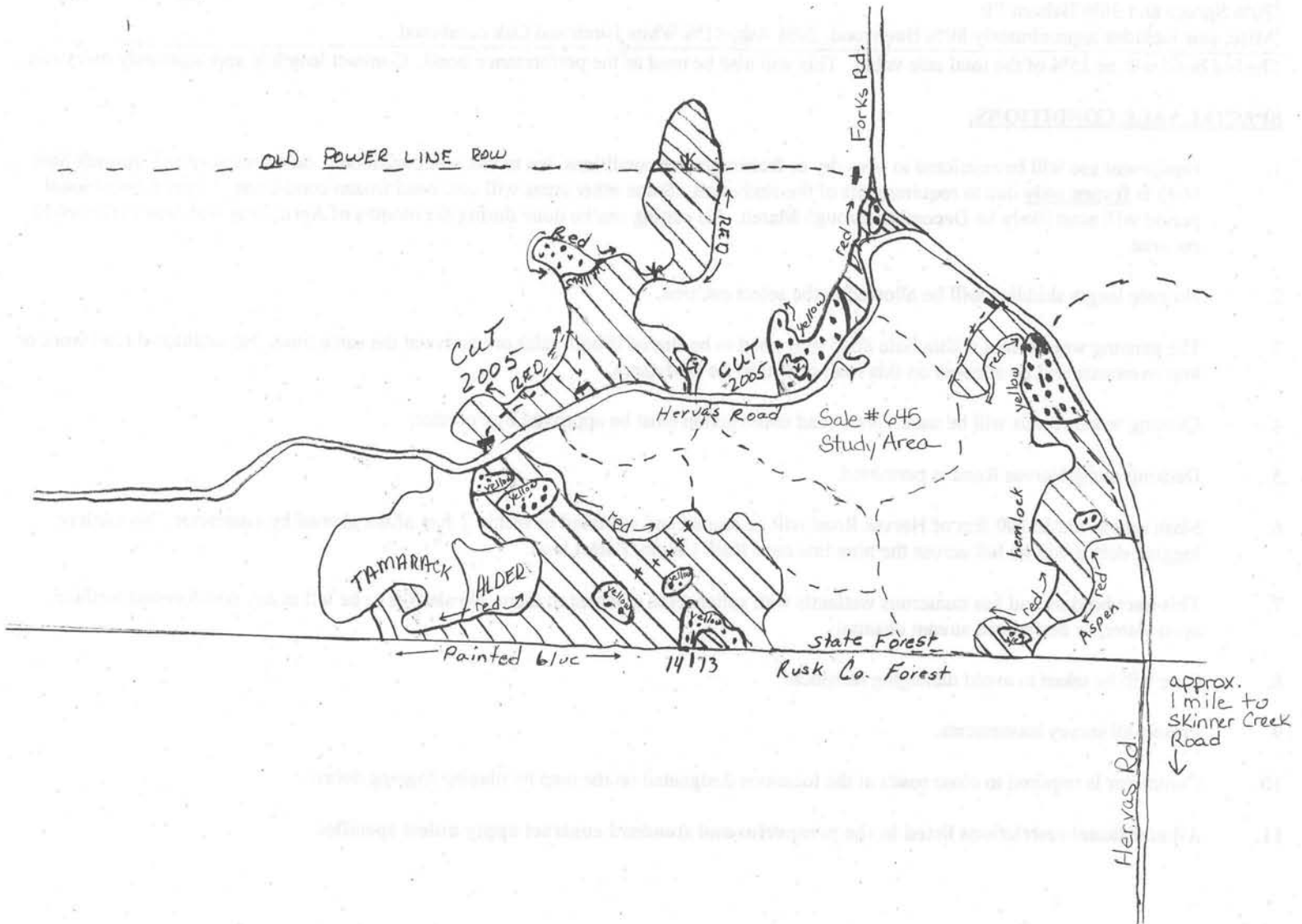


Select Cut Area (125 acres) – Bounded by red, blue paint lines, and road. Harvest all trees marked with orange paint. Sever all orange marked unmerchantable stems (canopy gaps).



Aspen Area (27 acres) – Bounded by yellow and red paint line and road. Cut all trees greater than 2" except for hemlock, white pine, and oak.
