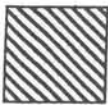

The bid bond will be 15% of the total sale value. This will also be used as the performance bond. Contract length is approximately two years, but Area "A" must be harvested within one year. **Storm damage occurred July 2006.**

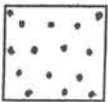
**SPECIAL SALE CONDITIONS:**

1. Equipment use within sale area will be restricted to very dry or frozen ground conditions due to wet soil conditions. Trail use for equipment and **hauling will be restricted to frozen conditions only** due to significant investment of recreational vehicle registration monies in the trail. General operational period will most likely be December through March. No cutting can be done during the months of April, May and June in the select cut area.
2. No pole length skidding will be allowed except in the aspen areas.
3. Existing roads will be used. New road construction must be approved by Forester.
4. The areas west of or adjacent to the cross country ski trail may need to be harvested during the ski season. No trees will be felled onto ski trail. Extreme caution is needed when cutting within 100 feet of ski trail. No slash will be allowed on or within 20 feet of the ski trail. Slash that is within 100 feet of the ski trail will be lopped and scattered to within 2 feet of the ground by contractor. No cutting within 100 feet of ski trail during weekends.
5. The snowmobile trail will be kept free of debris and 3" of packed snow will be maintained on snowmobile trail, weather permitting. Wood will be decked far enough off of trail so as not to impede snowmobile traffic or endanger snowmobile users. Slash that is within 100 feet of snowmobile trail will be lopped and scattered to within 2 feet of the ground by contractor.
6. Use of designated wildlife openings for decking is permitted. The topsoil shall not be disturbed and these openings are to be free of all logging debris at the end of the sale.
7. Contractor is required to close roads at designated map locations by placing either a berm or logging debris.
8. **All additional restrictions listed in prospectus and standard contract apply unless specified.**

**Tract 15-07 (Flambeau Hills Salvage)**



Select Cut Area (126 acres) – Bounded by red paint lines. Harvest orange marked trees within the designated boundaries. Leave, do not cut snags/cull trees marked with an orange X.



Aspen Area (56 acres) – Bounded by yellow paint and or yellow and red paint together. Cut all trees greater than 2" except for: 1) hemlock, 2) white pine, 3) red pine, 4) spruce.



Aspen area "A" is more heavily damaged and must be harvested the first year.
