The bid bond will be \$1000.00. This will also be used as the performance bond. Contract length is approximately one year.

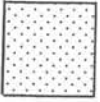
**SPECIAL SALE CONDITIONS:**

1. Equipment use will be restricted to very dry or frozen ground conditions. The two aspen areas indicated on map need frozen conditions due to wet soil conditions. General operational period will most likely be December through March. **The ATV/Snowmobile trail running through select cut area can only be used during frozen conditions** due to gravelling project. The select cut area west of the ATV/Snowmobile trail could be cut during very dry conditions if accessed through wildlife opening.
2. No pole length skidding will be allowed in the select cut area.
3. The selection cut area on the west side of the ATV/Snowmobile trail has moderate to steep terrain.
4. Existing woods roads will be used. Landings will be located far enough off of the snowmobile trail to avoid snowmobile traffic. Any decking on Snuss Blvd. must have prior approval from Draper Township.
5. Slash that is within 100 feet of Snuss Blvd. and the ATV/Snowmobile trail will be lopped and scattered to within 2 feet of the ground by the contractor. No slash or logging debris will be left across the blue line onto private land.
6. Use of designated openings for decking is permitted. The topsoil shall not be disturbed and these openings are to be free of all logging debris at the end of the sale.
7. Watch for small wetlands throughout the sale. Wheeled or tracked harvesting equipment will only operate within 15 feet of wetlands when the ground is frozen. No slash is to be left in any non-forested wetland.
8. **All additional restrictions listed in prospectus and standard contract apply unless specified.**

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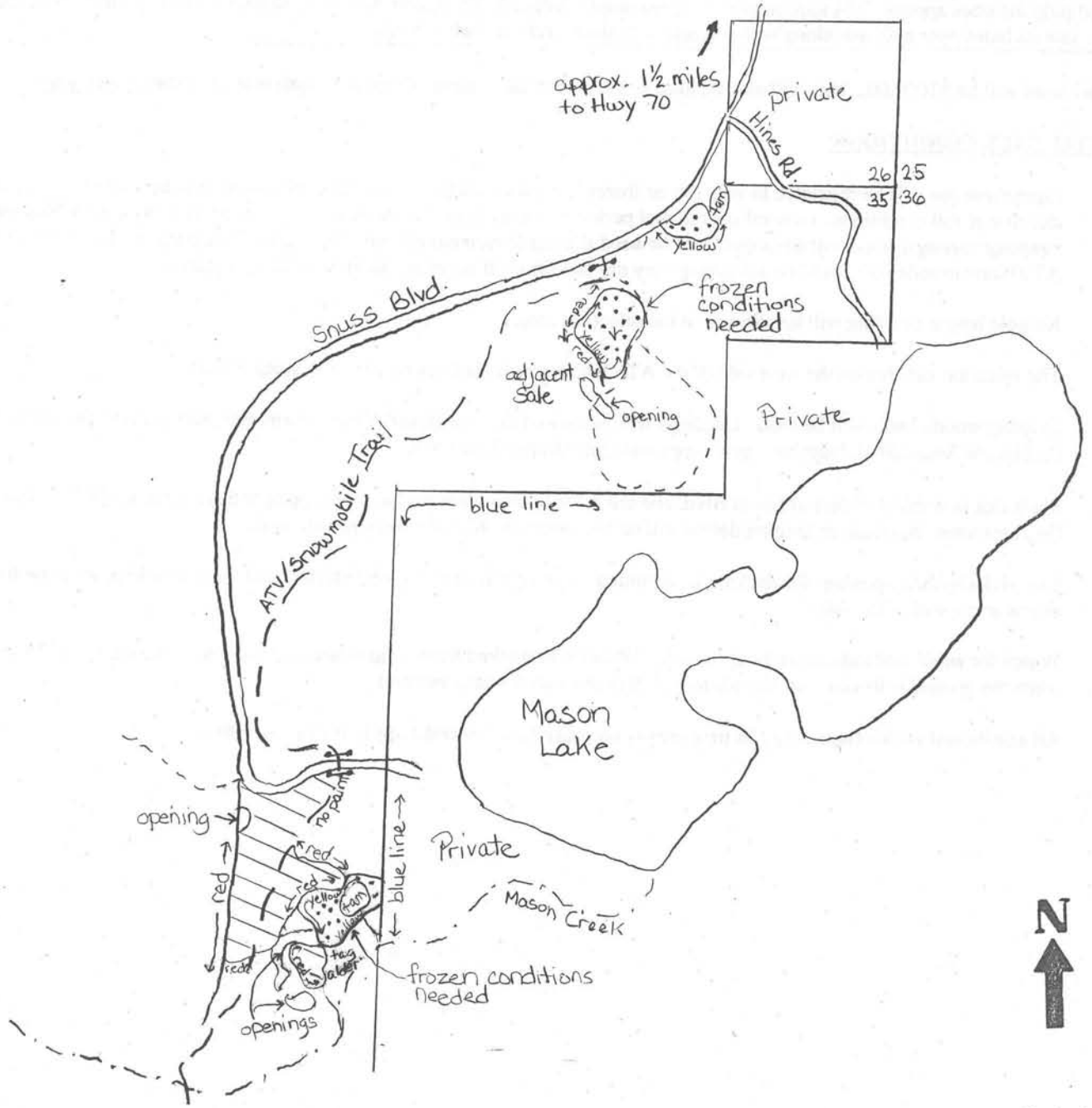


Select Cut Area (17 acres) – Bounded by red paint lines and road. Harvest all trees marked with orange paint. Sever all orange marked unmerchantable stems (canopy gaps).



Aspen Area (11 acres) – Bounded by yellow and blue paint lines. Cut all trees greater than 2" except for 1) hemlock, 2) white pine, 3) spruce, 4) tamarack, and 5) balsam with 2 sticks or less.
