²Misc. saw includes 25% hard maple, 42% ash, 20% basswood, and 13% yellow birch.

The bid bond will be \$500.00. This will also be used as the performance bond. Contract length is approximately one year.

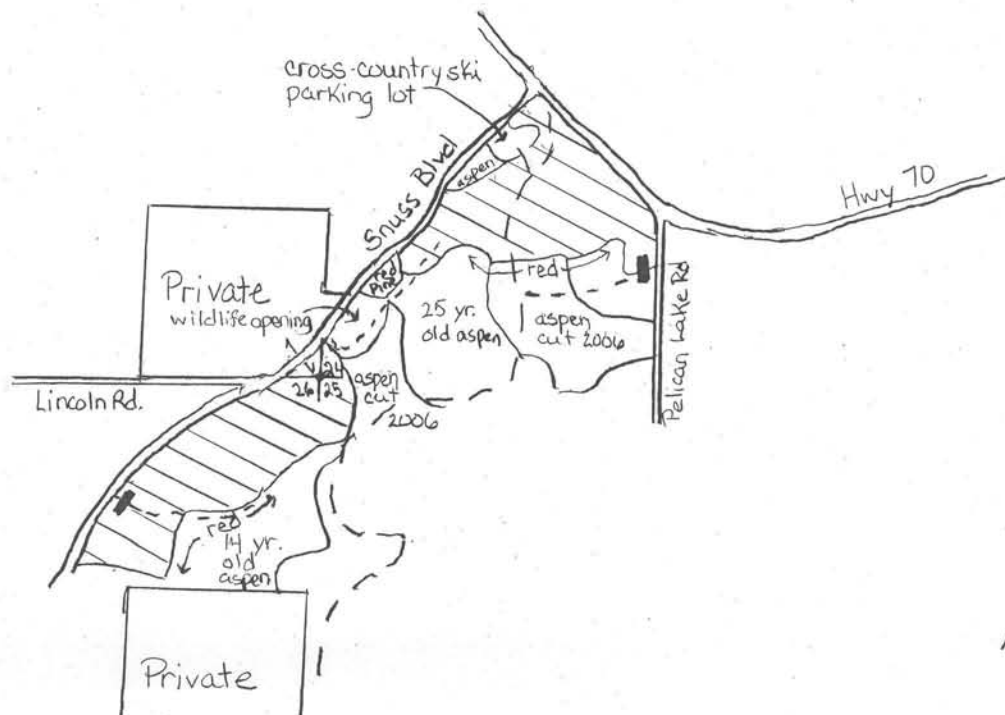
SPECIAL SALE CONDITIONS:

- Equipment use will be restricted to dry or frozen ground conditions. This sale should be able to be cut during a dry summer. No cutting can be done during the months of April, May and June in the select cut area.
- No pole length skidding will be allowed in the select cut area.
- The wind damage on this sale area occurred in July 2006. It had been selectively cut before the wind storm. The majority of the volume is in the southern piece of this sale.
- Existing woods roads and landings will be used.
- Slash that is within 100 feet of Hwy. 70, Snuss Blvd, and the ski trail will be lopped and scattered to within 2 feet of the ground by the contractor. No slash or logging debris will be left onto private land.
- Ski trail may not be used for hauling and can be crossed only at Forester's discretion.
- Use of designated wildlife opening for decking is permitted. The topsoil shall not be disturbed and this opening is to be free of all logging debris at the end of the sale.
- Contractor is required to replace existing berms designated on map.



Salvage Area (acres) – Bounded by red paint line and road. Harvest all trees marked with orange paint. Sever all orange marked unmerchantable stems (canopy gaps).
