What is CLEAN?



The Contaminated Lands Environmental Action Network (CLEAN) is an inter-linked system of databases that provides information on different contaminated land activities in Wisconsin, to assist with the investigation, cleanup and eventual re-use of those lands.

Through CLEAN, there are two main ways to view information about contaminated properties:

1) *BRRTS on the Web*: an on-line database of more than 60,000 contaminated properties and activities across the state (*BRRTS* stands for Bureau For Remediation and Redevelopment Tracking System); and

2) *RR Sites Map*: a web-based mapping system of contamination data.

The DNR's Remediation and Redevelopment (RR) Program operates and maintains CLEAN. The RR Program's goal is to help restore the environmental and economic health of communities throughout Wisconsin.

How Can CLEAN Help You?

Using CLEAN, you can find, download and print information about:

- cleanups that are still underway;
- cleanups that are completed;
- continuing obligations (land use controls);
- financial assistance (e.g. DNR loans and grants);
- liability incentives (e.g. liability clarifications and exemptions); and
- other redevelopment assistance, including brownfields information.



BRRTS On The Web

BRRTS On The Web (BOTW) is an on-line database that provides information on contaminated properties and other activities in Wisconsin. Updated daily. You can view a graphic display for some *BRRTS on the Web* information via the RR Sites Map.

Use *BRRTS on the Web* if you want to find information about:

- ongoing or completed cleanups of contaminated properties;
- financial or liability assistance and exemptions;
- emergency spills;
- sites where DNR has determined no cleanup action is required; and
- properties identified by street address.

RR Sites Map

RR Sites Map is a web-based mapping system that allows a user to view different layers of contamination data using a Geographic Information System (GIS) tool. Updated on a regular basis. You can view a data-only display of all DNR sites via *BRRTS on the Web*.

Use *RR Sites Map* if you want to find information (including specific documents) about:

- cleanups that are completed with residual contamination; and
- cleanups that are completed with continuing obligations (land use controls).
