The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR), through grants from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), has partnered with the City of Milwaukee and the 30th Street Industrial Corridor Corporation (ICC) to assess brownfield properties in the 30th Street Industrial Corridor. "Brownfields" are abandoned or underused properties with known or perceived contamination.

Officials from the DNR and the city, and state and local health officials will be on hand at the Open House to talk about what brownfields are, how the partners are using the grant funds, what kind of work is being conducted, and future re-uses of these properties. Through this informal session, the partners will seek community input on these site assessments, with plans to host additional events in the future. We hope you can attend!
