Redevelopment Authority, City of Milwaukee	\$200,000	Menomonee River Valley, West End
Redevelopment will turn an old railroad shop into a storm-water park, community ball fields, a public trail and access to the Menomonee River.		
City of Delavan	\$200,000	Ann Street Railroad Corridor
The former Borg Manufacturing property will become green space with a storm-water retention area.		
City of Oshkosh	\$200,000	Riverside Park
Riverside Park will be expanded with a new amphitheater, a river-walk and a convention center where a coal gas production plant once stood.		
Redevelopment Authority, City of Milwaukee	\$125,000	Garden Park
A neighborhood park, garden and farmers market are planned at the location of the former blighted, tax delinquent Pulaski Building.		
City of Madison	\$87,745	Isthmus Park
A contaminated parcel will be cleaned up to become part of the new Isthmus Park in East Rail Corridor.		
City of Kenosha	\$84,585	Bain Elementary & Kenosha School of Language
A former railroad and auto yard will become a new school and sports field that will replace two dilapidated, overcrowded schools.		
City of Fond du Lac	\$50,000	Quick Freeze Redevelopment
The former Quick Freeze Superfund site will become a small park with a trail along the Fond du Lac River.		
Town of Geneva	\$25,449	Geneva Township Park
Two former gas stations will become the town's first park, at the entrance to the Lake Como subdivision.		
City of West Allis	\$18,221	West Allis Athletic Fields

This project will develop soccer fields and a parking area on a former city landfill, eligible for partial funding.

City of Eau Claire	\$5,000	Phoenix Park Development
A new farmers market will be located at the site of a former foundry and battery salvage yard.		
City of Waukesha	\$4,000	Hoover Park Recreational Area
This park with a picnic area, playground, rest-rooms and parking will be located on four blighted properties, eligible for partial funding.
