City of Green Bay	\$200,000	Finger Road Baseball Park
<p>Green Bay plans to construct four baseball diamonds with parking, concession areas and bleachers at the former H&amp;R Landfill site. The landfill is located in an area that is experiencing new growth and where demand for recreational facilities is high. The proposed facility will be available for multiple uses, including Little League and adult baseball games.</p>		
City of Racine	\$200,000	Pointe Blue Waterfront
<p>Racine coordinated with a private developer on the Pointe Blue development. Plans included turning a portion of the W.H. Pugh Oil Company and the Pugh Marina into the city's Lake Michigan Pathway, in addition to adjacent mixed-use development. The Lake Michigan Pathway would wind around the development as a gateway to Racine's North Beach.</p>		
City of West Allis	\$178,760	West Allis Athletic Fields
<p>West Allis, in partnership with the West Allis-West Milwaukee School District, plans to create a soccer complex and complete the renovation of adjacent athletic fields on the former City of West Allis Landfill. The landfill was closed and covered with an approved soil cap in the mid 1990s and this project will provide community-wide recreational and educational opportunities for all levels of athletic activity.</p>		
City of Milwaukee	\$138,165	The North End - Riverwalk Project
<p>Milwaukee will clean up contamination from the former Pfister &amp; Vogel/U.S. Leather Tannery, excavating the most contaminated soil and capping other areas. A permanent public easement in front of a condominium project will add 900 lineal feet to the city's 12 foot wide Riverwalk on the Milwaukee River near North Water Street.</p>		
City of Kaukauna	\$100,000	Konkapot Preserve Project
<p>Kaukauna is working on a green space project at the Former Lehrer Landfill site where they plan a prairie atop the 26 acre landfill. The area will include walking trails with interpretive kiosks throughout the prairie. The trails will provide access to the existing CE and Konkapot Trails.</p>		
City of Superior	\$88,000	Superior Amateur Hockey Association (SAHA) Facility Expansion
<p>Superior wants to expand the Superior Amateur Hockey Association (SAHA) facility where development has been delayed due to contaminated soils. After soil cleanup, the site would be used as an ice rink and athletic training facility that will host hockey, figure skating, broomball and community events.</p>		
City of Kaukauna	\$50,000	Kaukauna Utilities Redevelopment
<p>Kaukauna plans to redevelop a blighted industrial site into a distribution center and warehouse to support Kaukauna Utilities operations. The city will dispose of the existing building and other structural remnants of the salvage and recycling operations that were located here.</p>		
City of Racine	\$40,075	Washington Avenue West Boulevard Redevelopment Area
<p>Racine plans to create a small park on a site previously used for auto repair. The city's plans include green space, benches and a fountain. This proposed development will provide a green space as well as a gathering spot for public events.</p>
