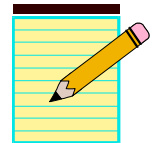

Approved Training

"NR114.07(5)(a) A person who desires to renew a certificate shall submit evidence of having met the continuing education requirements of par (b) on forms approved or provided by the department for approved training courses or other credit that they have successfully completed during the 3-year period. These may include, but are not limited to, courses sponsored by the department, or any university, or technical school, technical sessions at meeting of professional organizations, in-house training and correspondence courses. Failure to successfully complete and document the appropriate number of hours of continuing education training within the 3-year period shall result in rejection of a certificate renewal application."

"NR114.07(5)(3)(c) For both waterworks and wastewater treatment certified operators, not more than 6 hours of health and safety training may be used per year renewal period."

Continuing education credits are given on an hour- for- hour basis for training. A list of DNR approved continuing education training and contacts page with more information on registration and locations, is included in this newsletter (see pgs 10-15). If you attend one of the sessions listed on the DNR Training calendar, you will be issued a continuing education credit slip at the end of the training session.

Fill out your credit slip with your printed name, certification number and sign your credit slip and keep it on file until your certification renewal is due.

Renewing Your Certification



It's your responsibility to keep your certificate "Current". The date your certificate expires is printed on your certificate.

Wastewater operators Grade T, 1 or 2 require 18 hours, and Grades 3 and 4 require 24 hours of continuing education.

Municipal Water supply operators Grade T or 1 require 18 hours of continuing education. Surface water operators designated operator-in-charge is required to have 24 hours of continuing education.

Remember that a maximum of 6 hours of continuing education each 3- year renewal period may be health and safety related.

Six weeks prior to the expiration of your certificate we will send you a courtesy reminder letter. You don't need a "form" to renew your certificate. Read the letter and follow the instructions and send us your complete renewal packet. Include the reminder letter along with your packet; it will help us process your renewal quicker. Once we receive your complete renewal packet you will receive a new certificate within a week or two.

To renew your certificate without the reminder letter, write a note and let us know your change of address. Enclose a check for \$45 payable to Wisconsin DNR, your original continuing education slips from the past 3-year renewal period, (enclose the late fee of \$25 if your renewal is postmarked after your certificate expires) and mail it to:

Operator Training Report Form

If you attend training relevant to your certification and don't receive a credit slip, you can use the "Operator Training Report Form" to document your training. Use the form for any "in house" training or safety related training or other relevant training related to your certification.

The form is easy to use. Follow the directions on the form and be sure to attach some form of "proof of attendance" like registration verification or certificate of attendance. Education credits are given on an hour for hour basis. So...if you took an electrical course and it was 5 hours long (minus breaks and lunch) you could receive 5 hours of continuing education credits for completion of that training.

If you have any *questions* about whether a course meets the continuing education requirements, follow the instructions on the form and attach proof of attendance (i.e. certificate of completion or registration confirmation) and the agenda and you may mail it to your regional contact, requesting approval. The form will be reviewed for credit approval and returned to you to resubmit with your renewal packet.

Upgrading Your Certificate

...DOCUMENT YOUR EXPERIENCE

Wastewater and Waterworks operators can download an experience form(s) from our website:

Documenting your experience has a direct effect on your grade level. If you do not document your experience and send it to your regional coordinator to review, (see page 2 for address) your certificate will reflect the Grade T level. Use the Wastewater experience form for wastewater experience and the Waterworks for water experience. If you don't have web access, you may request the experience form from your regional coordinator.

Wastewater certificates can only be upgraded from Grade T, 1, 2, 3, 4 to the next grade level if you fill out an experience form. Grade levels are determined by the exams you have passed and years of experience you have in your record. Wastewater operators may document experience for the first year of full-time experience in each subclass and then for additional years of general wastewater experience up to 4 years. ***If you submit an experience form and it results in the advance to grade 3 or 4 your continuing education requirement increases to 24 credits needed per 3-year renewal period.*** Once you have reached a Grade 4 level of certification there is no need to fill out more experience forms.

Waterworks operators, once you have submitted an experience form for 1 year of full-time experience in any subclass, and it is approved, you don't need to submit any more experience forms. Grade 1 is the highest grade level.

All experience forms should be mailed to your regional coordinator to review, (see page 2 for addresses). Once your experience form has been submitted, if approved, you will receive an updated Certificate that reflects your grade level change.

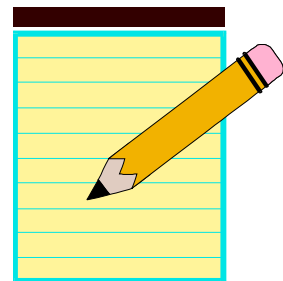
Frequently Asked Question (FAQ) # 1 (from Wastewater Operators)

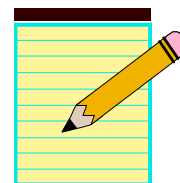
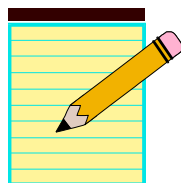
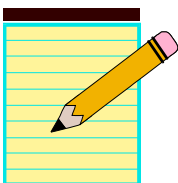

Drinking Water News and Views

Funding Operator Training

EPA grants help pay for drinking water operator training. Every year the DNR requests grant funding from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to pay for training and technical assistance for drinking water operators. This money is used to contract for a specific number of training sessions provided by a vendor. For 2009 and 2010 funding was less than in the past and our training contract with the Wisconsin Rural Water Association (WRWA) was significantly reduced—from 70 sessions a year to 44. This will undoubtedly affect training opportunities for operators; however, there are many training providers serving Wisconsin. Now more than ever it is important to plan for continuing education training to meet your renewal requirements.

Check the training calendar in this newsletter or on the DNR web site to see what is available. Trade associations (WRWA, Wisconsin Water Association, and others), vendors and on-line providers all have quality offerings.

Municipal Water Supply Operator Survey

DNR to survey drinking water operator opinions on training. A number of operators received a survey from the DNR that asks about your training experiences and how training can be improved. What issues does your water system face? Is your water system using or considering using advanced treatment? What types of training best meets your needs? And what training topics are you most interested in? The answers to these questions will help us use our limited resources to provide the best training possible.

The confidential survey was mailed to a group of 850 randomly selected Municipal Water Supply operators so it is important that those receiving the survey take a small amount of time to fill out and return the survey to us.
