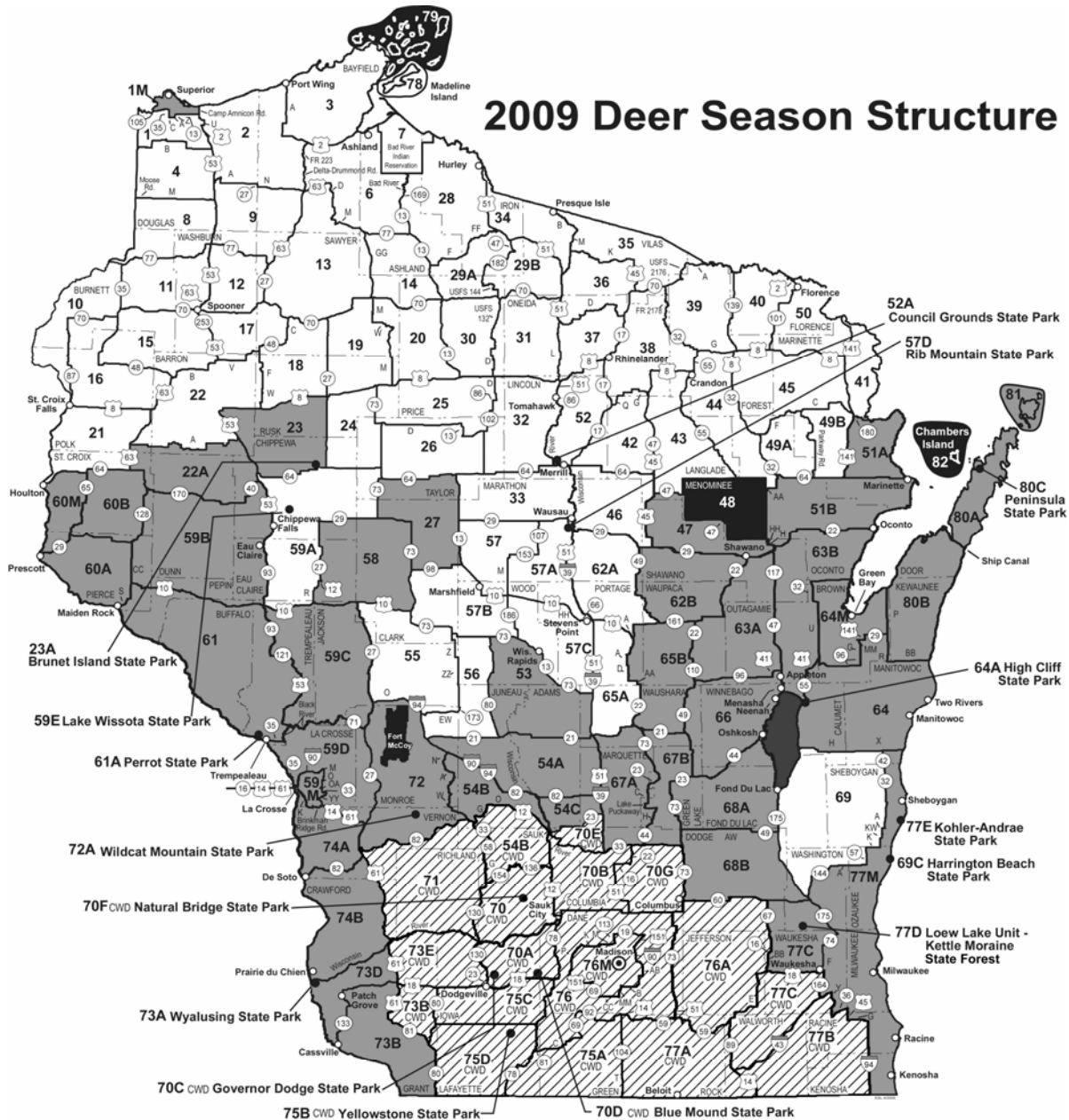


2009 Wisconsin Antlerless Deer Permit Information



- Herd Control Unit**
- CWD Unit - With Unlimited Earn-a-Buck Regulations**
- Regular Unit - Limited Number of Antlerless Deer Tags Available for Most Units**
- Non - Quota Area**

- Oct. 15-18 Antlerless only gun hunt* in herd control and CWD units only
 - Dec. 10-13 Antlerless only gun hunt* in all units statewide, except non-quota areas
- * Antlerless only restrictions apply to both gun and archery hunters

Regular Units and State Park Access Permits – Availability for antlerless tags (regular units) and State Park Unit Access Permits can be found on pages 2 and 3. Some regular units will not have antlerless tags available in 2009. Tags and permits for *even numbered* units will go on sale Saturday, August 22 at noon (but will not be sold August 23). Tags and permits for *odd numbered* units will go on sale Sunday, August 23 at noon. All units will resume sales on Monday, August 24 until sold out or until the hunting season ends.

Herd Control Units - There will be no Earn-a-Buck (EAB) regulations statewide (**Except CWD Units**) in 2009.

CWD Units – Unlimited earn-a-Buck regulations apply to all CWD units in 2009 (see page 4 for tagging options).

Even Numbered Regular Deer Management Units

Antlerless tags valid for the following even numbered regular units that have tags available will go on sale on Saturday August 22 from noon until midnight (\$12 each for residents, \$20 each for non-residents). Remaining tags will go on sale again on Monday August 24 and will remain on sale until the unit is sold out or until the hunting season ends. Tags may be purchased at a rate of one per hunter, per day.

Even Numbered State Park Units with Access Permits

Those interested in deer hunting Council Grounds (52A), High Cliff (64A), Wildcat Mountain (72A) or Peninsula (80C) State Park must purchase a State Park Access Permit (\$3) to deer hunt in the park. The following State Park Access Permits will go on sale on Saturday August 22 from noon until midnight. Any remaining Access permits for these units will resume sales on Monday August 24 until sold out or until the hunting season ends. State Parks may have special season dates or weapon restrictions. See *2009 Deer Hunting Regulations* for details. Special State Park deer hunting regulations will be mailed to those who purchase access permits early and can also be found at the respective State Park office or on the DNR website: <http://dnr.wi.gov>. *Permit holders for unit 52A (Council Grounds State Park) must purchase additional, unit-specific antlerless carcass tags if they wish to tag antlerless deer in this park.

Odd Numbered State Park Units with Access Permits

Those interested in hunting Brunet Island (23A), Rib Mountain (57D), Lake Wissota (59E), Perrot (61A), Harrington Beach (69C), Wyalusing (73A), Loew Lake (77D) or Kohler-Andrae (77E) State Park must purchase a State Park Access Permit (\$3) to deer hunt in the park. These State Park Access Permits can be purchased beginning **August 23 at noon** until sold out or until the hunting season ends. State Parks may have special season dates or weapon restrictions. See *2009 Deer Hunting Regulations* for details. Special State Park deer hunting regulations will be mailed to those who purchase access permits early and can also be found at the respective State Park office or on the DNR website: <http://dnr.wi.gov>. *Permit holders for unit 57D (Rib Mountain State Park) and unit 59E (Lake Wissota State Park) must purchase additional, unit-specific antlerless carcass tags if they wish to tag antlerless deer in the park.

Gun: Nov 21-29 (Statewide)

Oct 15 - 18 Antlerless Only (Herd Control & CWD)

Dec 10 - 13 Antlerless Only (Statewide)

Dec 24 - Jan 3, 2010 (CWD units only)

Muzzleloader: Nov 30 - Dec 9

Archery: Sept 12 - Nov 19 (early season)

Nov 30 - Jan 3, 2010 (late season)

Sept 12 - Jan 3, 2010 (CWD units only)

Youth Gun Deer Hunt: Oct 10 & 11

Oct. and Dec. Antlerless-Only Gun Hunts

The October antlerless-only gun hunt will take place in all CWD and Herd Control Units (see tables below). The December antlerless-only gun hunt will be in effect for all DMUs statewide, except Non-Quota Units and most State Park Units. Buck Authorization Stickers may be earned during these hunts if antlerless deer are harvested within a CWD unit. During these 4-day gun hunts, only the harvest of antlerless deer is permitted by both gun and archery if an antlerless-only hunt is occurring in that unit. For example, a hunter may harvest a buck by archery in Unit 13 while the October gun hunt is occurring in other units, since Regular units will not have an October antlerless-only hunt.

Earn-a-Buck (EAB) Pre-Qualification

Hunters that registered an antlerless deer during the 2008 deer hunting season in the following deer management units should have received a yellow *2008-2009 Earn-a-Buck Authorization Sticker* from a deer registration station: 22A, 54B, 54C, 59B, 59C, 59D, 59M, 60B, 60M, 61, 61A, 62B, 63A, 64, 64A, 64M, 65B, 66, 67A, 67B, 68A, 68B, 72, 72A, 73A, 73B, 73D, 74A, 74B, 77C, 77D, 80A, 80B, 80C, 81 and all CWD units. **These stickers are only required to tag bucks harvested in CWD units during the 2009 hunting season.** Hunters that register antlerless deer in CWD units during the 2009 hunting season must obtain their “2009-2010” buck authorization stickers at the deer registration station upon registration.

In CWD units the Buck Authorization Sticker must be attached to the back of a valid deer carcass tag before tagging a buck. **Or**, an antlerless deer may be harvested and tagged before the buck, and both deer must be tagged and registered together by the same hunter. State Park and Metro Units: Season dates in State Parks and Metro Deer Management Units may differ from the statewide seasons listed above. Refer to the *2009 Wisconsin Deer Hunting Regulations* for specific season information.

Herd Control and CWD Units

Herd Control Units: Additional Antlerless Deer Carcass Tags for Herd Control units can be purchased, \$2 each for residents and non-residents, anytime at any license vendor or online. Antlerless Deer Carcass Tags valid in Herd Control units are not unit-specific and may be used to tag an antlerless deer in any Herd Control or CWD unit. The number of \$2 antlerless tags a hunter may purchase is unlimited.

CWD Units: After a deer hunting license is purchased, hunters may pick up additional “CWD Deer Carcass Tags.” Four free tags may be picked up per day. Tags may be picked up at DNR Service Centers that are open to counter service during business hours, and at select DNR licensing agents and deer registration stations within CWD units.
