

**BROWNTOWN-CADIZ SPRINGS STATE RECREATION AREA
2009 DEER SEASON REGULATIONS**

(See the 2009 Wisconsin Deer Hunting Regulations for additional regulations)

1. Gun deer hunting in the open areas of Browntown-Cadiz Springs State Recreation Area are the same season structure as 75A.
Note: archers are required to wear blaze orange during any firearm season, including the October 10-11 Youth Hunt, October and December antlerless only hunts, the regular 9-day gun hunt, muzzleloader season, and Holiday Hunt.
2. All legal firearms and for deer hunting in Green County as well as bow and arrow are legal for use in Browntown-Cadiz Springs State Recreation Area this deer season. This includes rifles, shotguns, muzzleloaders, and handguns. Please see the *2009 Wisconsin Deer Hunting Regulations* pamphlet for further information on legal weapons. All firearms must be unloaded and enclosed within a carrying case and bows must be unstrung or enclosed within a carrying case when in or on a motor vehicle or within a closed area of the property intensive use area.
3. Some areas of the state recreation area are closed to hunting (see map on reverse side). A wounded deer moving into the closed area may not be pursued by the hunter. Park rangers or the Conservation Warden must be informed by the hunter of the location of any wounded animal within the closed area. They will evaluate the situation and may authorize the hunter to recover the deer.
4. All parking and traffic regulations apply during the seasons. Vehicles shall be operated only on established roads and parking permitted only in established parking lots and shoulders of established roads.
5. **It is illegal to hunt within 50 feet of the roadway's center or discharge a firearm or shoot an arrow from a bow from or across a road. It is illegal to shoot within 100 yards of a building devoted to human occupancy.**
6. Park admission stickers are required on all motor vehicles parked within the state recreation area (\$7/day or \$25/annual for vehicles with Wisconsin license plates; \$10/day or \$35/annual for vehicles without Wisconsin license plates). Admission stickers are available at any time at the park office. If the office is not staffed, admission stickers may be purchased at the self-registration box at the park office.
7. No permit is needed to hunt the open areas of the Browntown-Cadiz Springs State Recreation Area.

Unlimited Earn-a-Buck Seasons

Unlimited Earn-a-Buck (EAB) regulations are in effect for open areas of Browntown-Cadiz Springs State Recreation Area during the following season dates:

Archery:	Sept. 12, 2009 – Oct. 14, 2009 Oct. 19, 2009 – Dec. 9, 2009 Dec. 14, 2009 – Jan. 3, 2010
Gun:	Nov. 21, 2009 – Nov. 29, 2009
Muzzleloader:	Nov. 30, 2009 – Dec. 9, 2009
Holiday Hunt:	Dec. 24, 2009 – Jan. 3, 2010

Unlimited Antlerless Only Hunts

Unlimited antlerless only hunts are in effect for the dates listed below. Deer may be harvested using a firearm or a bow. No antlered deer may be taken during the antlerless only hunts. During these seasons you will receive an EAB sticker for every antlerless deer harvested.

Gun/Archery:	Oct. 15, 2009 – Oct.18, 2009 Dec. 10, 2009 – Dec. 13, 2009

Tagging Instructions (see pages 8-10 in the *2009 Wisconsin Deer Hunting Regulations* pamphlet for complete tagging instructions)

Hunters may use any of the tags listed below to tag a buck or an antlerless deer in the CWD-MZ. For these tags to be valid for a buck, a Buck Authorization sticker must be attached to the back of the tag or an unregistered antlerless deer tagged by the same hunter accompanies the buck deer until both are registered.

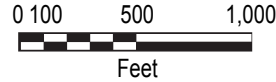

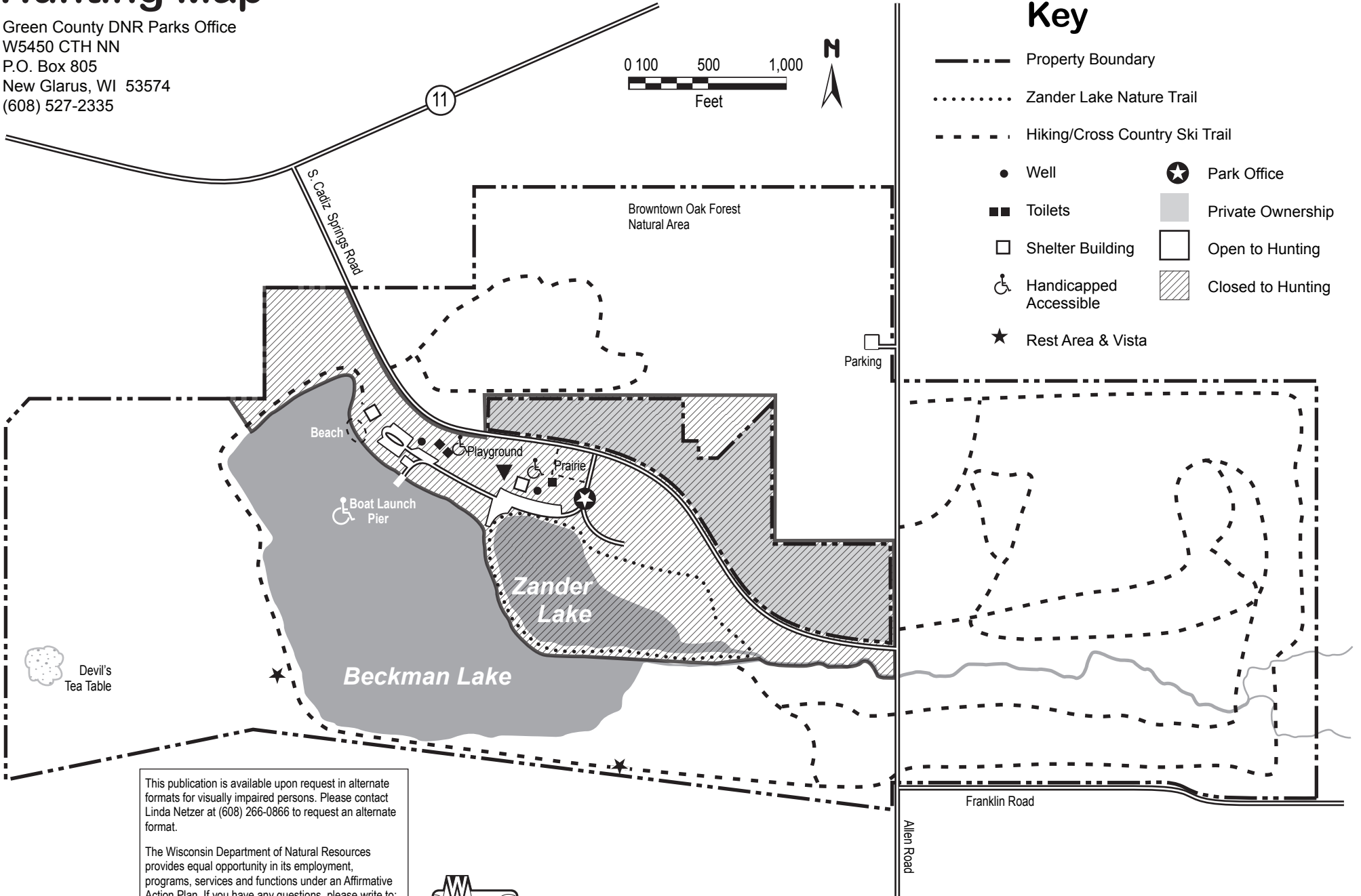
Browntown-Cadiz Springs State Recreation Area Hunting Map
