SUMMARY:

The Department of Natural Resources greatly appreciates the donation to the Endangered Resources Program of \$55,500 from the Whooping Crane Eastern Partnership (WCEP). As directed by WCEP, \$48,000 will be used in support of whooping crane data management and analysis, and \$7500 will be used in support of aerial and ground monitoring of whooping cranes.
