To the Conservation Congress Fond du Lac County

The Riverside Hunting and Fishing Club at N7473 Palm Tree Rd., Saint Cloud, Wisconsin is proposing a resolution to remove the size limit of bass on Wolf Lake. Wolf Lake is located in eastern Fond du Lac County, north and east of highway WH in the town of Marshfield. The main reason for the removal of the size limit is from the advice of fish biologist, John Nelson, of the Plymouth D.N.R. Office. We have received a \$4,125.00 grant through the Fond du Lac County Parks & Recreation Department to plant walleyes in the lake. Wolf Lake at present has too many large-mouth bass. The walleyes we have planted in the last seven years are starting to take hold. The walleyes are from 7 to 10 inches when released to the lake in late fall at a cost to contributors of about \$1.65 per fish. In the past seven years Riverside contributors have spent over \$10,000 on this project. John Nelson said the removal of the bass size limit would lessen the amount of bass by people fishing and help the walleye population stabilize and grow since bass eat walleyes.
