

Index to Files

To facilitate file search requests and open record requests related to the June 2008 flooding event in the Lake Delton area, the Department of Natural Resources has scanned the historical dam records for the dams that hold Lake Delton and Mirror Lake. The scanned documents reflect the agency's record for both of these dams until just prior to the flooding event. In addition, a digital version of the Order for Dam Repairs that was issued to the Village of Lake Delton on June 17, 2008 and the 2002 floodplain analysis which set the 100-year flood elevation for Lake Delton are also included in the scanned documents.

Separate file folders have been created for the Dell Creek Dam (Lake Delton) and for the Delton Dam (Mirror Lake). Records contained within these folders include;

Lake Delton

Field File: This includes the notes and pictures from field visits, database information and some calculations done for inspections.

Correspondence File: Correspondence received and sent by the DNR or its predecessor agencies relating to the dam.

Dam Plans: Plans or specifications related to the construction or reconstruction of the dam.

OM Plan: Operation and Maintenance Plan for the dam

Consultant Inspection: Report from a consultant's inspection of the dam.

Dam Photos: Higher resolution of historic photos from the dam file and database. The first 5 numbers in the file name are a dam identifier, the next 6 are the 2 digit month, day and year, and the last two numbers are a sequential numbering of the photos from that day.

Case by Case Floodplain: Information submitted for the 2002 floodplain analysis for Lake Delton

Order: Digital copy of the Dam Repair Order issued to the Village of Lake Delton on June 17, 2008.

Mirror Lake

Field File: This includes the notes and pictures from field visits, database information and some calculation done for inspections.

Correspondence File: Correspondence received and sent by the DNR or its predecessor agencies relating to the dam.

Dam Plans: Plans or specifications related to the construction or reconstruction of the dam.
