EMERGING THEMES THE CAC NEEDS TO ADDRESS

Public Safety

- How to deal with local ordinances that are in effect and restrict one or more activity?
- How to address public perception vs. reality of safety concerns and hunting?
- How to factor in differences in urban areas vs. rural areas?
- How do property shape, size, location, attributes and adjacent property uses affect safety concerns?

Protection of Unique Plant or Animal Communities

- How are these unique and sensitive communities identified?
- What are reasonable restrictions to protect these resources?
- How do property shape, size, location, attributes and adjacent property uses affect protection concerns or needs?

Usership Patterns

- How are priority uses of a property established?
- How do property shape, size, location, adjacent property uses and other attributes come into play?
- What methods exist to manage potential conflicts on a property? What's acceptable and justifiable to users and landowners?
- How much influence should the following have in prohibiting activities:
 - Seller contingencies (loss of acquisition opportunities)?
 - Landowner mission/interests (DNR, LUG or NCO)?
 - General public's concerns and interests?
- How is agreement reached on when a prohibition or restriction is warranted?

Review Process

- What would a reasonable review process look like when a prohibition is anticipated?
 - How to avoid undue complexity, bureaucracy, time, etc.?
 - When in the process does the review occur?
 - Who can bring an appeal?
- Should the Natural Resources Board be involved? At what point? If not how is a final decision made, by whom?
- How can flexibility be built in to the process?
