#### Welcome and Report on Information Requests

Pat Henderson welcomed the group to their third meeting. He reminded the committee that there are two meetings remaining after today. Pat also pointed out that information requests from the last meeting were mailed to members in a packet, except for information about eligibility of individual groups for Stewardship funds. Determinations are made related to pieces of property, not groups, so the department did not produce information about group eligibility.

BJ Panke reviewed the day's agenda and other logistics and pointed out the ground rules and committee charge posted on the wall. She reminded the committee about the name tent tip-up technique for indicating wanting to speak and reminded the group to stay on task and topic and to even out their participation.
